

Ordinance #26

"Amending Ordinance #10 of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo."

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:-

Section 1 Section 11, of Ordinance #10 of the Board is hereby amended to read as follows:-

In the last Monday of January of each year at six o'clock P.M., all taxes then unpaid are delinquent and thereafter the Tax Collector must collect for the use of the Town an addition of ten percent thereon. All taxes on all personal property unsecured shall be due and payable immediately after the assessment of said personal property is made.

Section 2 All acts required to be done toward collecting delinquent taxes are hereby extended 60 days after the time set forth in said Ordinance #10.

Section 3 This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
