

Ordinance # 28

"Providing for the conduct of sparring exhibitions"

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:-

- Section 1- It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to engage in or conduct a sparring exhibition in the Town of San Anselmo, excepting such persons shall constitute a duly incorporated club having its principal place of business on the said Town of San Anselmo.
- Section 2- The number of rounds of any sparring exhibition given by said club shall not exceed Ten (10) rounds and the gloves used thereat shall not be less than 5 ounces each in weight.
- Section 3- No person shall engage in sparring at such exhibitions before having been first examined by a physician and received a certificate from such physician that he is in perfect physical condition.
- Section 4- Any club desiring to give such sparring exhibition in said Town of San Anselmo shall first make application to this Board in writing, which application shall set forth that said club has been duly incorporated, and that said club if granted such permit to obtain a license will conduct such sparring exhibition in accordance with the ordinances and laws in force in said Town of San Anselmo. If the Board determines to grant such permit it may order that the Marshal issue a license to such applicant upon its paying a license fee of Ten (10) Dollars.
- Section 5- That at all such sparring exhibitions the club giving the same shall employ at its own expense two peace officers to

purpose of maintaining order during
such sparring exhibitions.

and be in force from and after the date
of its passage.
