

Ordinance # 31

"Relating to the Licensing of Peddlers, Solicitors, and other Agents, Amending Ordinance # 20 of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo."

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:—

Section 1 Section 2 of Ordinance No 20 of the Board of Trustees is hereby amended to read as follows:

* Every person, firm, association or corporation who shall solicit or take orders within said Town for the exchange, sale, barter or delivery of any goods, wares or merchandise, not then in his actual possession, as a peddler must procure a license therefor from the Town Marshal, and pay for such license the sum of Five Dollars per quarter year provided; however, that this section shall not apply to salesmen or agents for wholesale houses or firms who solicit orders from and sell for re-sale to retail dealers, or to manufacturers for manufacturing purposes.

Section 2 This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
