

Ordinance

- Ordinance #30 -

Relating to Additional Compensation of Assessor and Tax Collector of The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo as ordained as follows:

Action

1. The Assessor shall receive as his compensation for making out a list of all taxable property within the Town of San Anselmo and placing the value thereon, and performing all other duties required of him by law to be done and performed as such Assessor, 2 1/2 percent of all taxes hereafter to be collected.

Action

2. The Tax Collector shall receive as his compensation for collecting all taxes levied by the Board of Trustees, and for the performance of all other duties required of him by law to be done and performed as such Tax Collector 2 1/2 per cent of all taxes hereafter to be collected by him, as such Tax Collector. (Repealed by Ord. No. 105)

Action

3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Action

4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
