

Ordinance

"Establishing Width of Sidewalks"

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

The official width of all side-walks upon either side of the streets or roadways, within the Town of San Anselmo, is hereby fixed at One-fifth (1/5) of the width of said streets or roadways.

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage.
