

ORDINANCE 51

"REGULATING THE EXPLOSION OF BLASTS"

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Sect.I It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or Corporation to explode, or cause to be exploded, any powder or other explosive material for the purpose of blasting without first obtaining from the Board of Trustees a permit so, to do, which permit must specify the location of the blast or blasts for which it is granted; provided, however, that such permit shall not be granted until the applicant therefor shall have executed to the Town of San Anselmo, and filed in the office of the Clerk of the Board of Trustees, a good and sufficient bond with at least two sufficient sureties or a lawfully authorized surety company approved by the President of the Board of Trustees, in a sum not less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) nor more than Fifteen Hundred Dollars, (\$1,500.00), to be fixed and determined by the Board of Trustees in accordance with the estimated value of the property in the vicinity of the location of the proposed blast, said bond shall be conditioned that the permittee together with the sureties on said bond, their heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, shall be severally bound to pay any judgements which may be awarded against said permittee by reason of any damage to property or person sustained as the result of any blast made under and by virtue of said permit.

Sect.II Any person, firm, or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment for not more than three months (3), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Sect.III This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Circular No. 5.

Regulating the Explosives & Blasts.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Joaquin do ordain as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to explode, fire
cause to be exploded, any powder or
other explosive material, or the purchase
or blasting without a permit issued
by the Board of Trustees. A permit to do
which permit must specify the location
of the blast or blasts for which it is
granted; provided, however, that such
permit shall not be granted until the
applicant thereon shall have executed
to the town of San Joaquin, and filed
in the office of the Clerk of the Board of
Trustees, a bond with sufficient bond,
with at least two sufficient sureties
as lawfully authorized, security company
approved by the President of the Board
of Trustees, to a sum not less than One
Thousand Dollars (\$1000⁰⁰), nor more than
Fifteen hundred Dollars (\$1500⁰⁰), to be paid
and determined by the Board of Trustees
in accordance with the estimated value
of the property in the vicinity of the location
of the proposed blast. Said bond shall
be conditioned that the sureties, together
with the sureties on said bond, their heirs,
executors, administrators, and assigns, shall
be severally bound to pay any judgment
or fine decree which may be awarded
against, said sureties by reason of any
damage to property or persons sustained
as the result of any blast made under and
by virtue of said bond, herein.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation
who shall violate any of the provisions

of this Ordinance, shall be guilty of
misdemeanor, and upon conviction
thereof, shall be punished by a fine to
to exceed One hundred Dollars (\$100.00)
by imprisonment for not more than
Three (3) months, or by both, such fine
and imprisonment.

This Ordinance shall take effect
and be in force from and after its
passage.
