

PROVIDING FOR THE ABATEMENT OF NUISANCES
CAUSED BY THE FORMATION OF STAGNANT POOLS.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do
ordain as follows:

Section 1. It is and shall be unlawful for any person, firm,
corporation or association, either as owner or lessee of any
real property within the Town of San Anselmo, to keep, maintain,
or permit to exist, any hole or depression in the earth thereon,
wherein waters have accumulated, or may accumulate, and have be-
come or may become stagnant.

Section 2. The Board of Health of the Town of San Anselmo
is hereby authorized and directed to see to it that the provisions
of this Ordinance are complied with.

Section 3. Any person, firm, corporation or association who
shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be
guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be
punished by a fine not exceeding three hundred Dollars (\$300.00)
or by imprisonment for not more than three (3) months, or by both
such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force
immediately.
