

RESOLUTION NO. 73

REGULATING OBSTRUCTIONS UPON PUBLIC
STREETS AND SIDEWALKS.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do
ordain as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or
corporation, occupying or having charge or control of any
premises, to place, or cause to be placed, or suffer to remain
upon the sidewalk, or upon the half of the street in front of
such premises, any article or substance which shall obstruct the
passage of such street or sidewalk for more than one (1) hour
at a time.

Section 2. The provisions of Section 1 of this Ordinance
shall not apply to:

- (a) Goods or merchandise in actual course of receipt, delivery
or removal.
- (b) Electric lights or telegraph poles, or hydrants.
- (c) Ornamental trees planted along the outer line of the side-
walks, within the curb line or barriers for the protection of
such trees.
- (d) Watering troughs placed by permission of the Board of
Trustees upon the sidewalks for the accomodation of the public.

Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation, who shall vio-
late any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be guilty of
a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction, shall be punished by a
fine not exceeding Three hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or by im-
prisonment for not more than Three (3) months, or by both such
fine and imprisonment.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in
force immediately.

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Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, occupying or having charge or control of any premises, to place, or cause to be placed, or suffer to remain upon the sidewalk, or upon the half of the street in front of such premises, any article or substance which shall obstruct the passage of such street or sidewalk for more than One (1) hour at a time.

Section 2. The provisions of section 1 of this Ordinance shall not apply to.

(a) Goods or merchandise in actual course of receipt, delivery or removal.

(b) Electric lights or telegraph poles, or hydrants.

(c) Ornamental trees planted along the outer line of the sidewalks, within the curb line or barriers for the protection of such trees.

(d) Watering troughs placed by permission of the Board of Trustees upon the sidewalks for the accommodation of the public.

Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation, who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Three hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or by imprisonment for not more than Three (3) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately.
