#### ORDINANCE NO. 93.

CALLING AND PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION

TO BE HELD IN THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO, ON THE

9TH DAY OF APRIL, 1912, TO SUBMIT TO THE JUALI
FIED VOTERS OF SAID TOWN FIVE (5) PROPOSITIONS

FOR INCURRING A BONDED INDEBTEDIES OF SAID

TOWN TO PAY FOR CERTAIN MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENTS,

NAMELY; STREET WORK, THE ACQUISITION AND CON
STRUCTION OF A GERTAIN MURICIPAL STREET, THE OIL
ING OF THE ROADS IN SAID TOWN, THE TOWSTRUCTION

OF A SHWER FROM THE LANDSALE SCHOOL HOUSE, AND

A FOOT BRIDGE ACROSS SAR ANSELMO CREEK.

THEREAS, the Board of Erustees of the Town of San Anselmo a city of the Sixth Blass, in the Bounty of Marin, State of California, by resolution passed and adopted at regular meeting of said Board on the 14th day of February, 1912, at its council chamber, by the affirmative vote of all of the Pive (5) members of said Board of Trustees of said Town, did determine that the public interest and public necessity demanded the acquisition, construction and completion of certain municipal improvements, which are set forth and described in Section One (1) of this ordinance, as Proposition No. 1, Proposition No. 2, Proposition No. 3, Proposition No. 4, and Proposition No. 5, respectively, and that the cost of said improvements, and each of them, will be too great to be paid out of the ordinary annual income and revenue of said municipality; and

adoption by the Scard of Trustees, was by the President of said Board of Trustees (who is the Executive of said municipality) duly approved in writing over his official signature on said 14th day of February, 1912; and said resolution was thereupon on said 14th day of February, 1912, certified by the Town Clerk

of said Town and filed in is office, and now remains on file and of record therein; and

THIRTAS, the indebtedness now proposed to be incurred together with all other indebtedness of said Town of Sar Anselmo does not, in the aggregate, exceed Fifteen per cent (15.) of the assessel value of the real of personal reporty in said. Town of San Anselmo:-

Proposition To. 1:- The issuance of bonds of the Town of San Inselmo is the rincipal mount of Seventeen thousand Dollars (\$17,000.00) to pay the cost of grading, manadamizing and roun ing up, including the construction of necessary drainage, itches and culverts, upon the unimproved streets in said Town.

The total cost of said steet work, that is to say, of said grading, manadamizing and rounding up, including the construction of necessary rainage, ditches and culverts, being hereby estimated at the sum of leventeen thousand Dollars (\$17.000.00).

Proposition to 2:- The issuance of bonds of the Town of San inselme in the principal amount of Six the sand Dollars (\$6,000.00), to say the sest of the ciling of the roads in said Town.

The total most of s oiling of said roads being

hereby estimated at the sum of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00).

Proposition No. 3:- The issuance of bonds of the Town of San Anselmo in the principal amount of Three thousand Dollars (33,000.00), to pay the cost of the construction of a sewer from and beyond the Lansdale School House, and the acquisition of the necessary right of way therefor.

of said necessary right of way therefore being hereby estimated at the sum of Three thousand Dollars (\*3,000.00).

Proposition No. 41- The issuance of bonds of the Town of San Anselmo in the principal amount of the thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00), to pay the cost of the acquisition, construction and completion of a public street, Forty (41) feet in width, extending from Cak Street to Rose (venue, including the acquisition of the necessary right of way therefor, and the grading, macadamizing of draining the same.

The total cost of the said pollin street, including the acquisition of the necessary right of way therefor, and the grading, macademizing and draining the same being hereby fixed at thesum of Six thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00).

Proposition No. 5:- The issuance of bonds of the Town of San Anselmo in the principal amount of Six hundred and fifty Dollars (\$650.00), to jay the cost of the erection, construction and completion of a foot bridge across San Anselmo Creek, commencing opposite the San Anselmo epot, and running to and connecting with Oak Street.

The total cost of the erection, construction and completion of said bridge being hereby estimated at the sum of Six hundred and fifty Dollars (\$650.00).

Section Two: - That said Board of Frustees purposes to issue and sell bonds of the Town of San Arselmo for the purposes poses aforesaid in the amount of Thirty-two thousand, six hundred

and fifty Dollars (\$32,650.00) if two-thirds of the qualified voters of said flown voting at said special election shall vote in favor of each of said Five (5) propositions; and in the event that any of said Five (5) propositions shall fail to receive the affirmative vote of two-thirds of said electors, then, and in that event, the amount of honds of said flown which said heard of Trustees purposes to issue and sell will be the amount of all of the bonds specified in the other said vive (5) propositions which whall have been approved and authorized by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of said electors voting it said election. Said bends shall be negotiable in the form and of the character known as serial, and shall bear interest at the rate of Five percentum (5%) per annum, payable semi-annually, and both principal and interest shall be payable at the office of the Treasurer of said Town, in Jold Coin of the United States.

San Anselmo does hereb: submit to the qualified voters of said

Town at said special election the said Five (5) propositions

for issuance of bonds which are hereinbefore set forth and designated respectively as Proposition No. 1, Proposition No. 2, Proposition No. 3, Proposition No. 4 and Proposition No. 5, and designates and refers to said Five (5) propositions in the summary of each of them so numbered and designated in the form hereinafter prescribed for the hallot to be used at said election.

Section Four: The polls at the polling place hereinafter designated shall be opened at six o'clock in the merning
of said day of election, and shall be kept open continuously,
thereafter until six o'clock in the afternoon of said day of
election, when said polls shall be closed and the election officers shall then proceed to convass the ballots cest thereat.

Section Five: No newspaper being published in the fown of San Anselmo, it is ordered that notice of said election shall be given by posting of copies of this Ordinance in Three (3)

public places in said Town of San Anselmo for at least Two (2) successive weeks prior to said election day. The front of the Town Hall, the intersection of Ross Avenue with the Red Hill and Ross Landing Road, and the bridge across the San Anselmo Creek opposite Ross Valley Avenue, are hereby selected and designated as the Three (3) most public places in said Town where said copies shall be posted; and the Town Clerk shall cause such posting to be made.

Section Six: - Said apportal election shall be held and conducted and the votes thereof canvassed and the returns thereof made and the results asserts in and are determined as herein provided, and in all particulars not prescribed by this Ordinance. such special election shall be hald as provided by law for the holding municipal elections in said "own. "he returns of said special election shall be made out and signed by the efficers of election and shall be by them deposited with the Town Clerk, together with the ballots cast at said special election; and this Board shall meet and canvage said returns on the first Wonday after said election; and if upon such canvass it shall be found that at least two-thirds of the qualified voters of the Town of San Anselmo at said special alection voted in favor of any of said Five (5) propositions, then bonds of the "ewn of San Anselmo in the amount of such propositions as may have been equapproved, shall be issued by said Town as aforesaid.

Section Seven: For the holding of said special election, this Board of Tractees hereby forms and establishes one election precinct which is bounded by the corporate limits of said Town and embraces all the territory within said corporate limits, to be known as special Bord Plection Precinct No. 1. The location of the polling laces of said precinct for said election is hereby fixed at the office of the Town Clerk in the Town Hall on Oak Street, and the following officers are hereby

designated and appointed therefor, namely; Inapector, William Bernard; Judge, Silas Moore; Clerk, John C. Campbell; Ballot Clerks, Peter McMann and James Maguire. The said persons appointed as election officers are hereby found and declared to be legally qualified for their said respective positions.

Section Eight: - All persons shall be mutitled to vote at said a ecial election who come within the terms or comply with the requirements of this section. Every person who was a qualified elector at the general State election immediately proceding the holding of said special election and who was registered as required by law as a qualified elector of any procine? included in said Town of San Anselmo and who continues to reside within the exterior boundaries of said flown until the time of the holding of said special election shall be entitled to vote at said special election without other or additional regis-Il other persons in order to be entitled to vote at tration. said special election must be registered in the manner required by Sections 1094, 1096 and 1097 of the Political Code of the State of California, as we elector of and within the said special precinct. Such registration must be made and had in accordance with the provisions of Sections 1094, 1098 and 1097 of the Political Code, provided that such registration shall be in progress at all times except the twenty-five (25) days immediately preceding said special election.

Forty (40) feet in width, extending from Oak Street to hose 'venue, including the acquisition of the necessary right of way therefor, and the grading. macadamizing and draining the same?

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## PROPOSITION NO. 5.

Shall the Town of Sar Inselmo incur a bonded indebtedness of \$650.00 for the cost of the erscrion, corretraction and completion of a foot bridge across San Anselmo Creek, commencing opposite the San Anselmo Depot, and running to and connecting with Cak Street?

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Said ballots shall have printed on the back thereof the words "Municipal Tickets."

Section Ten: - Said bonds if issued will be sold by said Town to the highest bidder for cash and for not less than par value after advert sing for sealed proposal thereon.

Section Eleven: The resent assessed valuation of all the taxable property of said Town of San Anselmo as shown by last equalized assessment book thereof is the sum of \$1,242,075.00, and said Town has an outstanding bonded indebtedness of \$69,000.70.

Section Twolver- This ordinance shall be forthwith

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entered upon the minutes of this Board and in the Ordinance Book of said Town, and shall take effect upon its reseage and approval.
