

ORDINANCE NO. 99

ESTABLISHING THE GRADE OF A PORTION OF BANK STREET, BETWEEN THE EASTERLY LINE OF THE RED HILL AND ROSS LANDING ROAD AND A POINT 138 FEET, 6 INCHES, EASTERLY FROM THE EASTERLY LINE OF SAID RED HILL AND ROSS LANDING ROAD, SAID BANK STREET BEING IMMEDIATELY EAST OF THE NEW DEPOT AT SAN ANSELMO STATION.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The official curb grade of Bank Street, between the Easterly line of the Red Hill and Ross Landing Road and a point 138 feet, 6 inches, Easterly from the Easterly line of said Red Hill and Ross Landing Road, is hereby established in accordance with the following elevations:

At a point where the center line of Bank Street intersects the Easterly line of the Red Hill and Ross Landing Road, the grade shall be, and is hereby, fixed and established at 49 feet above Town base.

At a point in the center line of Bank Street, 138 feet, 6 inches, Easterly from the Easterly line of said Red Hill and Ross Landing Road, the grade shall be, and is hereby, fixed and established at 47 feet, 1 inch, above Town base.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval.
