

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CARRYING OF LIGHTS ON CARRIAGES, BICYCLES AND OTHER VEHICLES IN THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:-

Section 1.- It shall be unlawful for any person to drive or cause to be driven, in, upon, or over any street, avenue, lane, highway or other public place, in the Town of San Anselmo, any cart, wagon, carriage, bicycle, bicycle tandem, or other vehicle, other than a motor vehicle, during the period from a half hour after sunset to a half hour before sunrise, unless such vehicle shall have at least one lighted lamp showing a white light, visible under normal atmospheric conditions at least two hundred (200) feet in the direction toward which said vehicle is proceeding.

Section 2.- The term "motor vehicle", as used in Section 1 hereof, shall include all vehicles propelled otherwise than by muscular power.

Section 3.- Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars, or by imprisonment not exceeding ten (10) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
