

ORDINANCE NO. 132

AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 107 AND
REPEALING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 107.
RELATING TO DISPOSITION OF MANURE.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do
ordain as follows:

Section 1.- Section 3 of Ordinance No. 107 is hereby amended
to read as follows:


"If said Box is placed outside of the Stable and on an open
Lot, the same shall be made of Galvanized Iron. The Contents of
the box are to be removed as often as filled. All manure not
utilized for the fertilization of gardens and lawns, within the Town
shall be disposed of by the owner or occupant of the premises where-
in such material has accumulated, either by conveying same or
causing same to be conveyed beyond the Town Limits or other place
as directed by the Board of Trustees. Said Manure not actually
utilized for fertilizing gardens or lawns, within said Town shall
be removed at least once a week. Manure utilized for fertilizing
purposes must be spread over the surface of the ground to a depth
not exceeding two inches and turned under at once.

Section 2.- Section 4 of Ordinance No. 107 is hereby re-
pealed.

Section 3.- This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force
immediately after its passage and adoption.

Section 4.- Every person who shall violate any of the pro-
visions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor,
and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not ex-
ceeding Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars or by imprisonment for a period not
exceeding thirty days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 5.- All Ordinances and parts of ordinances in con-
flict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.
