

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 29 ESTABLISHING  
THE WIDTH OF SIDEWALKS

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do

ordain as follows:

Section 1.- The official width of all sidewalks upon

either side of the streets or roadways, within the Town of San

Anselmo is hereby fixed at one-fifth (1/5) of the width of the

said streets or roadways, unless otherwise ordered by the said

Board of Trustees.

Section 2.- This ordinance shall take effect immediately

after its passage and adoption.
