

AMENDING SECTIONS 3, 4, 5 of ORDINANCE NO. 89

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1: Section 3 of Ordinance No. 89 is hereby amended and made to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person to kindle or light or cause to be kindled or lighted any bon fire on any Public Highway, unless a written permit has been obtained from the Fire Marshall of the Town of San Anselmo so to do.

Section 2: Section 4 of Ordinance No. 89 is hereby amended and made to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person to kindle or light or cause to be kindled or lighted any bon fire on any vacant lot, unless the owner or lessee of said vacant lot has first obtained from the Fire Marshall of the Town of San Anselmo written permission so to do.

Section 3: Section 5 of Ordinance No. 89 is hereby amended and made to read as follows:

The Owner or person having in his possession or under his control, on any premises, any hay, straw or forage of any kind, paper or other substance which has been rendered useless or unmerchantable, by reason of any fire on said premises, or any other debris resulting from such fire, must remove the same from such premises within twenty-four (24) hours after notice so to do from the Fire Marshall of the Town of San Anselmo.

Section 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5: This ordinance shall go into full force and effect thirty days after its final passage.
