

ORDINANCE NO. 158

AN ORDINANCE CALLING AND PROVIDING FOR, AND GIVING NOTICE OF A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ON SATURDAY, DECEMBER 13th, 1919, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF SAID TOWN PROPOSITIONS TO INCUR BONDED DEBTS BY SAID TOWN FOR PAVING CERTAIN MAIN HIGHWAYS WITH CONCRETE PAVEMENT AND BITUMINOUS SURFACING, AND CONSTRUCTING EIGHT (8) CONCRETE BRIDGES, IN SAID TOWN.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo did, on the 17th day of November, 1919, by a vote of two-thirds of the members of said board, adopt a resolution declaring that public interest and necessity demanded the paving of certain main highways in said town, and also the construction of eight (8) concrete bridges therein, the cost of each and all of which will be the great to be paid out of the ordinary annual income and revenue of said municipality,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1. -- A special election is hereby called and ordered to be held in the Town of San Anselmo, State of California, on

SATURDAY, DECEMBER 13th, 1919

for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of said town propositions to incur bonded debts by said town for

FIRST -- The construction and completion of a Portland cement concrete pavement with bituminous surfacing on the following highways in said town, to-wit:

On the Red Hill and Ross Landing Road, from Bolinas Avenue to the San Rafael and Olema Road; and on the San Rafael and Olema Road for its entire length within said town.

The estimated cost of said highways and the amount of the principal of the indebtedness to be incurred therefor is \$61,500.00; and the rate of interest to be paid on said indebtedness is not to exceed five per centum per annum, payable semi-annually.

SECOND -- The construction and completion of a Portland cement concrete pavement with bituminous surfacing on the following highways in said town, to-wit:

On San Anselmo Avenue from Bolinas Avenue to Yolanda Station and scenic Avenue; from thence on scenic Avenue to Forest Avenue; and on Forest Avenue to Lansdale bridge; and on Willow Avenue from Lansdale bridge to the San Rafael and Olema Road.

The estimated cost of said highways and the amount of the principal of the indebtedness to be incurred therefor is \$38,500.00; and the rate of interest to be paid on said indebtedness is not to exceed five per centum per annum, payable semi-annually.

THIRD -- The construction and completion of four (4) Portland cement concrete bridges in said town over the San Anselmo Creek at the following places therein to-wit: -- One at the entrance to the Barber Tract, another on Madrone Avenue, another on Nokomis Avenue, and another on Willow Avenue (Lansdale).

The estimated cost of said bridges and the amount of the principal of the indebtedness to be incurred therefor is \$41,000.00; and the rate of interest to be paid on said indebtedness is not to exceed five per centum per annum, payable semi-annually.

FOURTH -- The construction and completion of four (4) Portland cement concrete bridges in said town at the following places therein, to-wit: -- One over the creek crossing on Magnolia Avenue, another over San Anselmo Creek at or near the eastern termination of Redwood Avenue, another over the San Anselmo Creek at Saunders Avenue, and another over the creek crossing on Saunders Avenue about midway between San Anselmo Creek and the San Rafael and Olema Road.

The estimated cost of said bridges and the amount of the principal of the indebtedness to be incurred therefor is \$18,900.00; and the rate of interest to be paid on said indebtedness is not to exceed five per centum per annum, payable semi-annually.

Section 2. -- The special election hereby called and ordered to be held shall be held and conducted, and the votes thereat received and canvassed, and the returns thereof made, and the result thereof ascertained, determined and declared as herein provided, and in all particulars not recited herein, according to the laws of the State of California providing for and governing elections in the Town of San Anselmo; and the polls for such election shall be and remain open during the time required by said laws.

The ballots to be used at said special election shall be such as may be required by law to be used thereat, and in addition to any other matter required by law to be printed thereon, shall appear thereon the following:

MUNICIPAL TICKET

To vote for a proposition, and thereby authorize the incurring of a bonded indebtedness to the amount of, and for the purpose stated therein, stamp a cross (X) in the voting square after the word "YES."

To vote against a proposition and thereby refuse to authorize the incurring of a bonded indebtedness to the amount of, and for the purpose stated therein, stamp a cross (X) in the voting square after the word "NO."

Also, said ballot shall have printed thereon the following:

PROPOSITION NO. 1. Proposition to incur a bonded debt by the Town of San Anselmo to the amount of \$61,500, gold coin of the United States, for the construction and completion of a Portland cement concrete pavement with bituminous surfacing on the following highways in said town, to-wit: --

On the Red Hill and Ross Landing Road, from Bolinas Avenue to the San Rafael and Olema Road; and on the San Rafael and Olema Road for its entire length within said town, such debt to bear interest at a rate not to exceed five per centum per annum, payable semi-annually in like gold coin.

PROPOSITION NO. 2. Proposition to incur a bonded debt by the Town of San Anselmo to the amount of \$38,500, gold coin of the United States, for the construction and completion of a Portland cement concrete pavement with bituminous surfacing on the following highways in said town, to-wit: --

On San Anselmo Avenue from Bolinas Avenue to Yolanda Station and scenic Avenue; from thence on scenic Avenue to Forest Avenue; and on Forest Avenue to Lansdale bridge; and on Willow Avenue from Lansdale bridge to the San Rafael and Olema Road.

from thence on scenic Avenue to Forest Avenue; and on Forest Avenue to Lansdale Bridge, and on Willow Avenue from Lansdale Bridge to the San Rafael and Olema Road; such debt to bear interest at a rate not to exceed five per centum per annum, payable semi-annually, in like gold coin.

PROPOSITION NO. 3. Proposition to incur a bonded debt by the Town of San Anselmo to the amount of \$41,000, gold coin of the United States, for the construction and completion of four (4) Portland cement concrete bridges in said town over the San Anselmo Creek at the following places therein, to-wit: --

One at the entrance to the Barber Tract, another on Madrone Avenue, another on Nokomis Avenue, and another on Willow Avenue (Lansdale), such debt to bear interest at a rate not to exceed five per centum per annum, payable semi-annually in like gold coin.

PROPOSITION NO. 4. Proposition to incur a bonded debt by the Town of San Anselmo to the amount of \$18,900 gold coin of the United States, for the construction and completion of four (4) Portland cement concrete bridges in said town at the following places therein, to-wit: --

One over the creek crossing on Magnolia Avenue, another over San Anselmo Creek at or near the eastern termination of Redwood Avenue, another over the San Anselmo Creek at Saunders Avenue, and another over the creek crossing on Saunders Avenue about midway between San Anselmo Creek and the San Rafael and Olema Road; such debt to bear interest at a rate not to exceed five per centum per annum, payable semi-annually in like gold coin.

Sample ballots containing the above matter required to be printed thereon shall be supplied to the electors of said Town of San Anselmo by the Town Clerk, but failure on the part of any elector to receive such sample ballot shall not be held to invalidate the election or affect in any manner the legality of any bonds that may be authorized thereat.

Section 3. -- Any qualified elector of the Town of San Anselmo may vote at said special election for or against any or all the propositions herewith submitted. To vote in favor of and to authorize the incurring of a bonded debt for the purpose set forth in a proposition, he or she shall stamp a cross (X) in the voting square to the right of the word "YES" printed opposite such proposition, and to vote against and refuse to authorize the incurring of a bonded debt for the purpose set forth in a proposition, he or she shall stamp a cross (X) in the voting square to the right of the word "NO" printed opposite such proposition.

A cross (X) stamped in the voting square to the right of the word "YES" shall be counted as a vote in favor of, and to authorize the incurring of a bonded indebtedness for the purpose set forth in such proposition; and a cross (X) stamped in the voting square to the right of the word "NO" shall be counted as a vote not in favor of, and a refusal to authorize the incurring of a bonded indebtedness for the purpose set forth in such proposition.

Section 4. -- There shall be two

special election precincts within said town for the purpose of holding such special election, which shall be known as "Special Election Precinct No. 1" and "Special Election Precinct No. 2," respectively.

"Special Election Precinct No. 1" shall consist of a consolidation of regular election precincts numbers One and Two as established by the county board of supervisors for holding regular county and state elections.

"Special Election Precinct No. 2" shall consist of the remaining territory in said town, and a consolidation of regular election precincts numbers Three and Four, as established by the county board of supervisors for holding regular county and state elections.

The polling place for "Special Election Precinct No. One" shall be at Arata's Store, opposite Yolanda Station, and the officers to conduct said special election in said precinct are hereby appointed and designated as follows:

Inspectors (2) Wm. Schultz and E. Morgan
Judges (2) C. F. Cauthard and L. Edwards
Clerks (2) Mrs. Marcia Homburg and Miss Ray Sanders.

The polling place for "Special Election Precinct No. Two" shall be at the Town Hall, and the officers to conduct said special election in said precinct are hereby appointed and designated as follows:

Inspectors (2) Mrs. Emma G. Foley and Wm. Barnard
Judges (2) Mrs. Antoinette Hecht and Mrs. Carrie Wessell
Clerks (2) Chas. Cartwright and Thomas Cartwright

If any of the election officers aforementioned shall not be qualified to act or shall fail to appear at the opening of the polls on the morning of such election, the electors of such precinct present at the time shall appoint in his place, or her place, one who is qualified, who shall take the required oath of office as provided by the general election laws of the state.

At said special election the polls shall be opened at 6 o'clock a. m. of the day of such election, and be kept open until 7 o'clock p. m. of the same day, when the polls shall be closed except as provided in Section 1164 of the Political Code of the State of California.

The Town Clerk is hereby directed to procure all supplies that may be necessary to properly and lawfully conduct said special election.

When the polls are closed the officers of election shall count the ballots cast at such election, and canvass the votes cast respectively for and against the propositions herein stated, and make return thereof to the Board of Town Trustees in the time, form and manner required for the counting, canvassing, and returning of votes cast at other municipal elections held in said Town of San Anselmo.

Section 5. -- If, at said special election, it shall appear that two-thirds of all the votes cast thereat were in favor of and authorized the incurring of a bonded debt for any of the purposes set forth in the propositions hereinbefore stated, then such proposition shall be deemed to have been accepted by the electors, and bonds will be issued to defray the cost of the improvements hereby specified and to the amount stated

form and character known as "Ser-vals" and at least one-fortieth part of the principal sum of said indebtedness will be paid each and every year in gold coin of the United States until all of said bonds shall be paid.

Section 6. -- This ordinance shall be published once a week for two weeks prior to said day of election in the San Anselmo Herald, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published less than six days a week in said town, and this ordinance and such publication thereof shall constitute the notice of said election.

Section 7. -- This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
