

ORLINANCE NO. 171

AN ORLINANCE FORBIDDING THE SALE OR DELIBERY,
FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION, OF UNINSPECTED MEAT
AND UNWHOLESOME MEAT AND,MEAT FOOD PRODUCTS.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo
do ordain as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person,
firm, or corporation, or any agent or employee thereof, to
sell, barter or exchange for any thing of value, or deliver,
or otherwise dispose of, or to have in his or its possession,
within the Town of San Anselmo in the State of California, for
human consumption, the flesh of any cattle, calf, sheep, lamb,
goat or seine, which does not bear on each primal part thereof
the official approval stamp of either the United States Department
of Agriculture or the Department of Agriculture of the State of
California, or that of any political subdivision of the State of
California whose meat inspection is conducted in accordance with
requirements in no wise less than those of the United States
Department of Agriculture.

Primal parts shall mean the usual sections or cuts
of the dressed carcass commonly known in the trade, such as
sides, quarters, shoulders, hams, backs, bellies, etc, and beef
tongues, beef livers, beef hearts, beef heads and beef tails,
before they have been cut, shredded, or otherwise subdivided
preliminary to use in the manufacture of meat food products.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm
or corporation, or any agent or employee thereof, to sell, ~~barter~~
or exchange for anything of value, or deliver, or otherwise
dispose of, or to have in his or its possession, within the Town
of San Anselmo in the State of California, for human consumption,
any carcass of any cattle, calf, sheep, lamb, goat or swine, or
any part thereof, or the flesh of any thereof, or any meat or meat
food product, which is unsound, unhealthful, unwholesome or
otherwise unfit for food or for human consumption; and whenever any
thereof shall be found within said Town of San Anselmo the same
shall be marked or stamped by the Town Meat Inspector or his
authorized assistant, and be held for identification and be destroyed.


Section 3. It shall be the duty of the Town Meat
Inspector or any of his assistants to determine whether any meat

or meat food product is within the terms of Section 2 of this ordinance and in such determination he and they shall be guided by the specifications contained in the regulations of the Bureau of Animal Industry of the United States Department of Agriculture governing the inspection of meat.

Section 4. The Town Meat Inspector of the Town of San Anselmo, and each of his assistants, is hereby empowered to enter any place in said Town where meat or flesh of any of the animals mentioned in Section 1 of this Ordinance, or the product thereof may be held, kept, exposed or offered for sale, and every establishment where meat is manufactured into articles of food or preserved, cured, canned or otherwise prepared for food, and to inspect the same and any animal flesh, meat or meat food product therein; and whenever such flesh, ~~meat~~ or meat food product shall upon inspection and examination be found not to be stamped or branded as required by law, or whenever such flesh, meat or meat food product does not show by the brand or stamp affixed thereon as required by law that the same has been inspected and passed for food purposes in accordance with the requirements of Section 1 of this Ordinance, said meat inspector or any of his assistants shall condemn the same as unfit for food, shall mark and mutilate the same, making the fact of such condemnation apparent, and shall thereupon arrange for and accomplish its speedy destruction.


Section 5. Any person, firm or corporation, violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by imprisonment in the Town jail or in the County jail, for not to exceed thirty days, or by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars nor more than five hundred dollars, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall go into full force and effect thirty days after its final passage.


