

ORDINANCE NO. 192

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 162 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE DEFINING GARBAGE, PROVIDING FOR AND REGULATING THE KEEPING, COLLECTING AND DISPOSING THEREOF; MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO SPILL OR DEPOSIT GARBAGE IN PUBLIC PLACES OR UPON PUBLIC STREETS AND ALLEYS; FIXING RATES FOR COLLECTION OF GARBAGE; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR A VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.", PASSED AND APPROVED AUGUST 23, 1920, AND AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 167 PASSED AND APPROVED MAY 1, 1922, AND AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 175 PASSED AND APPROVED MAY 7, 1923, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION 8a RELATING TO THE LETTING OF CONTRACTS.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 162 entitled "An Ordinance Defining Garbage, Providing for and Regulating the Keeping, Collecting and Disposing Thereof; Making it Unlawful to Spill or Deposit Garbage in Public Places or Upon Public Streets and Alleys; Fixing Rates for Collection of Garbage; Providing a Penalty for a Violation of any of the Provisions of this Ordinance; and Repealing all Ordinances in Conflict Herewith.", passed and approved August 23, 1920, and as amended by Ordinance No. 167, passed and approved May 1, 1922, and as amended by Ordinance No. 175, passed and approved May 7, 1923, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be designated Section 8a, and to read as follows:


Section 8a. Upon the receipt of any such bids should the Board determine that the same are too low or are not fair or just, it may, at its option, reject the same or any or all thereof, and proceed, without further publication or notice, to let a

contract to, or enter into a contract with, such person or persons and upon such terms as shall seem to said Board to be for the best interests of said town, for the collection and disposal of garbage.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published once in the San Anselmo Herald, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in said Town of San Anselmo.

Section 3. And whereas garbage is accumulating in said town, and will continue to so accumulate, unless the same is disposed of, and it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the said town and of the people thereof that said garbage be collected and promptly disposed of, it is hereby declared by said Board that said facts constitute an urgency, and this ordinance is hereby passed for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of said town, and shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
