

AN ORDINANCE CALLING AN ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO, MARIN COUNTY, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, TO SUBMIT TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS THEREOF THE PROPOSITION OF INCURRING A BONDED DEBT BY SAID TOWN FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE COST OF CERTAIN MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENTS THEREIN.

WHEREAS the City Council and Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo, in the County of Marin, State of California, did on the 5th day of August, 1929, by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members of said board, adopt a resolution determining that the public interest and necessity demanded the acquisition and construction of certain municipal improvements in said Town, namely, the acquisition of a 600 Gallon Automobile Fire Truck Pumper, together with the necessary equipment therefor, 1500 feet of hose, the alteration of and addition to the present Fire House, the acquisition and installation of additional Fire Alarm boxes, the extension of the existing Fire Alarm system, and the installation of additional hydrants, and that the cost of said municipal improvements will require an expenditure greater than the amount allowed for such improvements by the annual tax levy and will be too great to be paid out of the ordinary annual income and revenue of said municipality; and

WHEREAS said resolution, after its said passage and adoption by said City Council and Board of Trustees, was by the executive of said municipality, namely, the President of said Board, duly approved in writing over his official signature on said 5th day of August, 1929, and said resolution was thereupon on said day certified by the Clerk of said Town and filed in his office and now remains on file and of record therein;

NOW, THEREFORE, the said City Council and Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1. An election is hereby called and ordered to be held in said Town of San Anselmo on Thursday, the 3rd day of October, 1929 for the purpose of submitting at said election to the qualified voters of said Town the proposition of incurring a bonded debt of said Town in the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) for the purposes set forth in said resolution, namely, the acquisition of a 600 Gallon Automobile Fire Truck Pumper, together with the necessary equipment therefor, 1500 feet of hose, the alteration of and addition to the present Fire House, the acquisition and installation of additional Fire Alarm boxes, the extension of the existing Fire Alarm system, and the installation of additional hydrants.

The estimated cost of the acquisition and construction of said municipal improvements is hereby estimated by said City Council and Board of Trustees at the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) for all of said improvements and said estimated cost of said improvements will require an expenditure greater than the amount allowed for such improvements by the annual tax levy and will be too great to be paid out of the ordinary annual income and revenue of said municipality.

Section 2. The assessed valuation of all the real and personal property of said Town of San Anselmo, as shown by the last equalized assessment roll thereof is the sum of Two Million Eight hundred and Seventy-five Thousand Four hundred Dollars (\$2,875,400.00) and there is no indebtedness, bonded or otherwise, now against said Town of San Anselmo, save and except the sum of One hundred and Fifty-six thousand, Six hundred and fifty Dollars (\$156,650.00); and the amount of said proposed bonded

indebtedness, to wit, the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000), together with all other indebtedness incurred or to be incurred is less than fifteen per cent (15%) of said assessed value.

Section 3. The City Council and Board of Trustees of said Town of San Anselmo propose to issue and sell bonds of said Town for the purposes set forth in said proposition, provided at least two-thirds ( $2/3$ ) of the qualified voters of said Town voting at said election shall vote in favor thereof. Said bonds shall be negotiable in form and of the character known as "Serial" and shall bear interest at the rate of five per cent (5%) per annum, payable semi-annually, both principal and interest payable at the office of the Treasurer of said Town of San Anselmo, in the County of Marin, State of California.

Section 4. The election hereby called and ordered to be held shall be held and conducted and the votes thereat received and canvassed, and the return thereof made, and the result thereof ascertained, determined and declared as herein provided, and in all particulars not recited herein such election shall be held as provided by law for holding municipal elections in said Town of San Anselmo.

The ballots to be used at said election shall be such as may be required by law to be used thereat, and in addition to any other matter required by law to be printed thereon there shall appear thereon under the heading of "INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS" a direction to the effect that to vote on the proposition there- by submitted stamp a cross (x) in the voting square after the word "Yes" or after the word "No"; and upon said ballots said proposition shall be stated in the following manner:

Shall the Town of San Anselmo incur a bonded indebtedness in the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) for the acquisition of a 600 Gallon Automobile Fire Truck Pumper, together with the necessary equipment therefor, 1500 feet of hose, the alteration of and addition to the present Fire House, the acquisition and installation of additional Fire Alarm boxes, the extension of the existing Fire Alarm system, and the installation of additional hydrants?

Section 5. There shall be two election precincts within said Town for the purpose of holding said election which shall be known as "Consolidated Voting Precinct A" and "Consolidated Voting Precinct B" respectively.

Consolidated Voting Precinct A shall consist of a consolidation of the regular election precincts Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4, as established by the County Board of Supervisors for holding regular county and state elections.

Consolidated Voting Precinct B shall consist of the remaining territory in said Town and a consolidation of the regular election precincts Nos. 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9, as established by the County Board of Supervisors for holding regular county and state elections.

The polling place for Consolidated Voting Precinct A shall be at Lansdale School House, and the officers to conduct said election in said precinct are hereby appointed and designated as follows:

The polling place for Consolidated Voting Precinct B shall be at the Town Hall, and the officers to conduct said

election in said precinct are hereby appointed and designated as follows:

Inspector (1) Emma G. Foley  
Judge (1) R. H. Milliard  
Clerks (2) Antoinette Hecht  
Dolores Sill

The said persons appointed as election officers are hereby found and declared to be legally qualified for their respective positions.

The polls at the polling places hereinbefore designated shall be open at six o'clock in the morning of the day of said election and shall be kept open continuously thereafter until seven o'clock in the afternoon of the day of said election, when the polls shall be closed except as provided in section 1164 of the Political Code of the State of California.

Section 6. Any qualified elector of the Town of San Anselmo who shall have been registered according to law during the years 1928 and 1929 and at least thirty days prior to said election may vote at said election for or against said proposition herewith submitted.

Section 7. , The Clerk of said Town is hereby directed to procure all supplies that may be necessary to properly and lawfully conduct said election and to procure and cause to be provided at the expense of said Town a sufficient number of indices to the affidavits of registration and a sufficient number of ballots and to furnish and prepare the same for use of the voters at said election.

Section 8. when the polls are closed the officers of election shall count the ballots cast and canvass the votes cast respectively for and against said proposition herein stated, and

make return thereof to said City Council and Board of Trustees as required by law, and the said City Council and Board of Trustees shall meet and canvass said returns on Monday, the 7th day of October, 1929 at the hour of eight o'clock P.M., and if upon said canvass it shall be found that at least two-thirds (2/3) of the qualified voters of the Town of San Anselmo voting at said election voted in favor of said proposition, then bonds of the Town of San Anselmo shall be issued in accordance with the proposition receiving said two-thirds (2/3) vote.

Section 9. This ordinance shall be published once a week for two weeks prior to said day of election in the Marin Herald, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published less than six days a week in said Town.

Section 10. This ordinance shall be forthwith entered in the Ordinance Book of said Town and shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
