

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: It is hereby determined by the Town Council of the Town of San Anselmo that said Town of San Anselmo is now the owner of that certain portion of the water works system located within that certain subdivision laid out and delineated upon a map thereof entitled "Morningside Court Map No. 2, San Anselmo, Cal." recorded in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Marin, State of California on January 7, 1925 in Map Book 5, page 35, which said portion of such water works system is more particularly described in the plans and specifications referred to in Resolution of Intention No.

92-A-4 of the Town Council of the Town of San Anselmo, to which reference is hereby made for further particulars, and that said Town Council of the Town of San Anselmo, being the legislative body of such town, does further determine that it is for the best interests of said town to sell and transfer the control and management of said portion of said water works system to the Marin Municipal Water District, a municipal water district, within whose exterior boundaries the said Town of San Anselmo is wholly included.

Section 2: The sale of the whole of such portion of said water works system and the transfer of the control and management thereof is hereby authorized to be made by the Town of San Anselmo to the Marin Municipal Water District for the sum of Three Thousand Seven hundred and Seventy and 18/100 — (\$3770.18) Dollars, which shall be payable in quarterly installments to the Town of San Anselmo, the said quarterly installments to be equal in amount to one-half of the gross revenue derived by the Marin Municipal Water District from consumers or patrons in said portion of the said water works system hereby referred to, during the preceding quarter, on the First day of July, the First day of October, the First day of January, and the First day of April in each year. The said purchase price hereinabove referred to and the deferred payments thereof shall

not bear interest. The said transfer shall be made under the provisions of that certain Act of the Legislature of the State of California entitled "An Act to Enable Municipal Corporations to Sell, Lease, or Otherwise Transfer the Control or Management of Water Works or Parts Thereof Belonging to Such Municipalities to Municipal Water Districts", approved May 15, 1923.

Section 3: It is further found and determined that a form of contract under which such transfer may hereafter take place has been approved by the Town Council of the Town of San Anselmo under the provisions of Resolution No. ~~A-7~~^{92-A} of said Town Council, to which said resolution was annexed the proposed form of contract to be entered into between said Town of San Anselmo and the Marin Municipal Water District, and reference is hereby made to said proposed form of contract so attached to Resolution No. ~~A-7~~^{92-A} of the Town Council of the Town of San Anselmo for further particulars.

Section 4: After the publication and taking effect of this ordinance, as hereinafter provided, the Mayor of the Town of San Anselmo shall execute said contract of sale on behalf of the Town of San Anselmo, and he is hereby authorized, empowered and directed so to do, and the Clerk of this Board is further directed to attest the said contract and to attach the seal of the Town of San Anselmo to said contract on behalf of said Town.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be published in the "Marin Herald", a newspaper published in the Town of San Anselmo, by four (4) insertions in said newspaper, said insertions to be made one week apart during said period of publication.
