## ORDINANCE NO. 234

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE TOWN OF SAN ANSEL-MO FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS OF SAID TOWN THE PROPOSITION OF INCURRING A BONDED INDEPTEDNESS OF SAID TOWN FOR THE ACQUISITION OF THE FOLLOWING MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT OF SAID TOWN. TO WIT: THE INCURRING BY SAID TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO OF A LONDED INDESTEDNESS BY THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF BOIDS TO BE KNOWN AS "MUNICIPAL INVESTMENT BONDS". THE PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE OF WHICH SHALL BE USED FOR THE PURCHASE OF MUNICIPAL SECURITIES OR EVIDENCES OF DEBT MITHER OF SAID TOWN OF SAN ANSBELIO OR OF BOR-OUGHS OR DISTRICTS THEREIN: INCLUDING MUNICIPAL BONDS OF SAID TOWN, BONDS OF BOROUGHS OR DISTRICTS THEREIN OR ANY BONDS OR LIENS ARISING OUT OF THE CONSTRUCTION OR ACQUIRING OF PUBLIC IM-PROVEMENTS BY LOJAL ASSESSMENT WITHIN SAID MUNICIPALITY; ING THE AMOUNT OF PRINCIPAL OF SAID INDESTEDNESS TO BE INCURRED THEREPOR: AND THE MAXIMUM RATE OF INTEREST TO BE PAID THEREON; PIXING THE DATE OF SAID ELECTION. THE MAINNER OF HOLDING THE SAME. ESTABLISHING ELECTION PRECINTS AND POLLING PLACES FOR LAID ELEC-TION AND APPOINTING BOARDS OF MLECTION THEREFOR, AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE THEREOF.

MEREAS the City council of the Town of San Anselmo by resolution passed and adopted at a regular meeting of said Council on the 11th day of February, 1936, by affirmative vote of more than two-thirds of all of its members, did determine that the public interest and necessity demand the acquisition of the municipal improvement hereinafter mentioned and did further determine the cost of said proposed municipal improvement will be too great to be paid out of the ordinary annual income and revenue of said municipality, which resolution was duly entered on the minutes of said meeting of said Council, and is now on file and of record in the City Clerk's office of said Town, now therefore,

Section 1. That a special municipal election be and is hereby ordered and will be held in said Town of San Anselmo on Tuesday the 14th, day of April, 1936, at which election shall be submitted to the qualified electors of said Town the proposition of incurring indebttedness of said Town in the principal sum of \$90,000.00. for the object and purpose of acquiring a municipal improvement of said Town of San Anselmo, to wit: The incurring by said Town of ban Anselmo of a bonded indebtedness by the issuance and sale of bonds to be known as "Municipal Investment bonds", the proceeds from the sale of which shall be used for the purchase of Municipal Securities or evidences of debt either of said Town of San Anselmo or of boroughs or Districts therein; including Municipal bonds of said Town. Bonds of Boroughs or Districts therein or any Bonds or liens arising out of the construction or acquiring of public improvements by local assessment within said municipality. That the estimated cost of said proposed municipal improvement is the sum of \$90.000.00 and the amount of the principal of said indebtedness proposed to be incurred for said municipal improvement is the sum of \$90,000.00.

That the said Council proposes to issue and sell bonds of said Town of San Anselmo in the said amount of \$90,000.00 for the object and purpose specified in the said proposition set forth in section 1 of this ordinance, if two-thirds of the qualified electors voting on such proposition at said special election shall vote in favor of said proposition. Said bonds shall be negotiable in form and of the character known as serials, and shall bear interest at a rate not exceeding five (5) percent, per annum payable semiannually.

Section 3. The said Council does hereby submit to the qualified electors of said Town of San Anselmo at said special municipal election this ordinance and the said proposition set forth in section 1. of this ordinance, and designates and refers to this

ordinance and said proposition in the form of ballot herein after prescribed for use at said election.

Section 4. The polls at the polling places hereinafter designated shall be opened at six (6:00) o'clock in the morning of said day of election and shall be kept open continuously thereafter until seven (7:00) o'clock in the evening of said day of election, when the polls shall be closed (except as provided in Section 1164 of the Political Code), and the election officers shall thereupon proceed to canvass the ballots cast thereat.

baid special election shall be held and conduct-Sestion 5. ed and the votes thereof canvassed, and the returns thereof made, and the result thereof ascertained and determined as herein provid ed; and in all particulars not prescribed by this ordinance said election shall be held as provided by law for the holding of municipal elections in said Town. The returns of said election shall be made out and signed by the election officers and shall be by them deposited with the Sity Clerk, together with the ballots cast at said election; and this Council shall meet at its usual meeting place and canvass said returns on Monday, the 20th, day of April, 1936, being the first Monday after said election, at the hour of eight (8:00) o'clock P. M.; and if upon such canvass it shall be found that at least two-thirds of the qualified electors of said Town voting on said proposition at said election voted in favor of said proposition, then bonds of said Town of San Anselmo in the said amount specified in said proposition, to wit; \$90,000.00, will be issued and sold by said Town for the purpose therein mentioned. Such bonds may be issued and sold by the Council as the Council shall determine, but for not less than their par value and accrued interest thereon to date of delivery.

Section 6. Whereas there is to be held in said Town of San Anselmo a General Municipal Election on Tuesday the said 14th, day of April, 1936, for the purpose set forth in Section 852 of the

Boroughs or Districts therein or any bonds or liens arising out of the construction or acquiring of public improvements by local assessment within said municipality.

Section 9. Each voter to vote for said proposition hereby submitted and for incurring said bonded indebtedness shall stamp a cross (X) in the blank space opposite the word "Yes" on the ball-ot to the right of said proposition, and to vote against said proposition and against incurring said indebtedness shall stamp a cross (X) in the blank space opposite the word "NO" on the ballot to the right of said proposition.

Section 10. This ordinance shall be published once a week for two successive weeks in the "Marin Herald" which is a newspaper published less than six (6) days a week in said Town of San Anselmo, to wit, weekly, and such publication shall constitute notice of said election. No other notice of the election hereby called need be given.

Section 11. This ordinance shall be forthwith entered upon the minutes of this Council and in the ordinance book of said Town. This ordinance being an ordinance ordering and calling an election shall take effect from and after its final passage and approval.

The foregoing ordinance was fully and regularly introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo held in said Town on the 10th day of March, 1936, and was thereafter, at an adjourned regular meeting of said City Council held in said Town on the 17th, day of March, 1936, duly passed and adopted by the following vote;

Municipal Corporation Act, Statutes of 1883 page 93 as amended by Statutes of 1935, and in the manner provided for such elections in an act entitled "An Act to Provide for and Regulate Municipal Elections in Cities of the fifth and sixth class "approved May 27th., 1919, Statutes 1919 page 928 as amended; Now therefore it is hereby ordained that for the conduct of said above mentioned Special Election, said special election be consolidated with said General Municipal Election; that the precincts, polling places and officers of election of said special election, shall be the same as those set forth in the notice of election of the above mentioned General Municipal Election which said notice of election is now on file in the office of the City Clerk of the Town of San Anselmo, to which said notice reference is hereby made for further particulars.

Section 7. All persons qualified to vote at municipal elections in said Town of San Anselmo upon the date of the election herein provided for shall be qualified to vote upon the proposition hereby submitted at said special election.

Section 8. The ballots to be used at said Special Election so consolidated with said General Municipal Election shall, in addition to the other matter required by law to be printed upon the ballots at such elections so consolidated, including such instructions to voters as are required by law, have printed thereon the following:
