

ORDINANCE NO. 234

1 AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE TOWN OF SAN ANSEL-
2 MO FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS OF SAID TOWN THE
3 PROPOSITION OF INCURRING A BONDED INDEBTEDNESS OF SAID TOWN FOR
4 THE ACQUISITION OF THE FOLLOWING MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT OF SAID
5 TOWN, TO WIT: THE INCURRING BY SAID TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO OF A
6 BONDED INDEBTEDNESS BY THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF BONDS TO BE KNOWN
7 AS "MUNICIPAL INVESTMENT BONDS", THE PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE OF
8 WHICH SHALL BE USED FOR THE PURCHASE OF MUNICIPAL SECURITIES OR
9 EVIDENCES OF DEBT EITHER OF SAID TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO OR OF BOR-
10 OUGHS OR DISTRICTS THEREIN; INCLUDING MUNICIPAL BONDS OF SAID
11 TOWN, BONDS OF BOROUGHES OR DISTRICTS THEREIN OR ANY BONDS OR
12 LIENS ARISING OUT OF THE CONSTRUCTION OR ACQUIRING OF PUBLIC IM-
13 PROVEMENTS BY LOCAL ASSESSMENT WITHIN SAID MUNICIPALITY; DECLAR-
14 ING THE AMOUNT OF PRINCIPAL OF SAID INDEBTEDNESS TO BE INCURRED
15 THEREFOR; AND THE MAXIMUM RATE OF INTEREST TO BE PAID THEREON;
16 FIXING THE DATE OF SAID ELECTION, THE MANNER OF HOLDING THE SAME,
17 ESTABLISHING ELECTION PRECINCTS AND POLLING PLACES FOR SAID ELEC-
18 TION AND APPOINTING BOARDS OF ELECTION THEREFOR, AND PROVIDING
19 FOR NOTICE THEREOF.

21 WHEREAS the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo by reso-
22 lution passed and adopted at a regular meeting of said Council on
23 the 11th day of February, 1936, by affirmative vote of more than
24 two-thirds of all of its members, did determine that the public
25 interest and necessity demand the acquisition of the municipal im-
26 provement hereinafter mentioned and did further determine the cost
27 of said proposed municipal improvement will be too great to be
28 paid out of the ordinary annual income and revenue of said munici-
29 pality, which resolution was duly entered on the minutes of said
30 meeting of said Council, and is now on file and of record in the
31 City Clerk's office of said Town, now therefore,
32 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. That a special municipal election be and is here-
2 by ordered and will be held in said Town of San Anselmo on Tuesday
3 the 14th, day of April, 1936, at which election shall be submitted
4 to the qualified electors of said Town the proposition of incurr-
5 ing indebtedness of said Town in the principal sum of \$90,000.00,
6 for the object and purpose of acquiring a municipal improvement of
7 said Town of San Anselmo, to wit: The incurring by said Town of
8 San Anselmo of a bonded ~~indebtedness~~ by the issuance and sale of
9 bonds to be known as "Municipal Investment bonds", the proceeds
10 from the sale of which shall be used for the purchase of Municipal
11 Securities or evidences of debt either of said Town of San Anselmo
12 or of boroughs or Districts therein; including municipal bonds of
13 said Town, bonds of Boroughs or Districts therein or any bonds or
14 liens arising out of the construction or acquiring of public im-
15 provements by local assessment within said municipality. That the
16 estimated cost of said proposed municipal improvement is the sum of
17 \$90,000.00, and the amount of the principal of said indebtedness
18 proposed to be incurred for said municipal improvement is the sum
19 of \$90,000.00.

20 Section 2. That the said Council proposes to issue and sell
21 bonds of said Town of San Anselmo in the said amount of \$90,000.00
22 for the object and purpose specified in the said proposition set
23 forth in section 1 of this ordinance, if two-thirds of the quali-
24 fied electors voting on such proposition at said special election
25 shall vote in favor of said proposition. Said bonds shall be ne-
26 gotiable in form and of the character known as "serials, and shall
27 bear interest at a rate not exceeding five (5) percent, per annum
28 payable semiannually.

29 Section 3. The said Council does hereby submit to the quali-
30 fied electors of said Town of San Anselmo at said special municipi-
31 pal election this ordinance and the said proposition set forth in
32 section 1. of this ordinance, and designates and refers to this

1 ordinance and said proposition in the form of ballot herein after
2 prescribed for use at said election.

3 Section 4. The polls at the polling places hereinafter de-
4 signated shall be opened at six (6:00) o'clock in the morning of
5 said day of election and shall be kept open continuously there-
6 after until seven (7:00) o'clock in the evening of said day of
7 election, when the polls shall be closed (except as provided in
8 Section 1164 of the Political Code), and the election officers
9 shall thereupon proceed to canvass the ballots cast thereat.

10 Section 5. Said special election shall be held and conduct-
11 ed and the votes thereof canvassed, and the returns thereof made,
12 and the result thereof ascertained and determined as herein provid-
13 ed; and in all particulars not prescribed by this ordinance said
14 election shall be held as provided by law for the holding of muni-
15 cipal elections in said Town. The returns of said election shall
16 be made out and signed by the election officers and shall be by
17 them deposited with the City Clerk, together with the ballots cast
18 at said election; and this Council shall meet at its usual meeting
19 place and canvass said returns on Monday, the 20th, day of April,
20 1936, being the first Monday after said election, at the hour of
21 eight (8:00) o'clock P. M. ; and if upon such canvass it shall be
22 found that at least two-thirds of the qualified electors of said
23 Town voting on said proposition at said election voted in favor of
24 said proposition, then bonds of said Town of San Anselmo in the
25 said amount specified in said proposition, to wit; \$90,000.00, will
26 be issued and sold by said Town for the purpose therein mentioned.
27 Such bonds may be issued and sold by the Council as the Council
28 shall determine, but for not less than their par value and accrued
29 interest thereon to date of delivery.

30 Section 6. Whereas there is to be held in said Town of San Ansel-
31 mo a General Municipal Election on Tuesday the said 14th, day of
32 April, 1936, for the purpose set forth in Section 852 of the

6 Section 9. Each voter to vote for said proposition hereby
7 submitted and for incurring said bonded indebtedness shall stamp
8 a cross (X) in the blank space opposite the word "Yes" on the ball-
9 ot to the right of said proposition, and to vote against said prop-
10 osition and against incurring said indebtedness shall stamp a cross
11 (X) in the blank space opposite the word "NO" on the ballot to
12 the right of said proposition.

13 Section 10. This ordinance shall be published once a week
14 for two successive weeks in the "Marin Herald" which is a news-
15 paper published less than six (6) days a week in said Town of San
16 Anselmo, to wit, weekly, and such publication shall constitute
17 notice of said election. No other notice of the election hereby
18 called need be given.

19 Section 11. This ordinance shall be forthwith entered upon
20 the minutes of this Council and in the ordinance book of said Town.
21 This ordinance being an ordinance ordering and calling an election
22 shall take effect from and after its final passage and approval.

23 The foregoing ordinance was fully and regularly introduced
24 at a regular meeting of the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo
25 held in said Town on the 10th day of March, 1936, and was there-
26 after, at an adjourned regular meeting of said City Council held
27 in said Town on the 17th, day of March, 1936, duly passed and a-
28 doped by the following vote;

1 Municipal Corporation Act, Statutes of 1883 page 93 as amended by
 2 Statutes of 1935, and in the manner provided for such elections
 3 in an act entitled " An Act to Provide for and Regulate Municipal
 4 Elections in Cities of the fifth and sixth class " approved May
 5 27th., 1919, Statutes 1919 page 928 as amended; Now therefore it
 6 is hereby ordained that for the conduct of said above mentioned
 7 Special Election, said special election be consolidated with said
 8 General Municipal Election; that the precincts, polling places
 9 and officers of election of said special election, shall be the
 10 same as those set forth in the notice of election of the above
 11 mentioned General Municipal Election which said notice of elec-
 12 tion is now on file in the office of the City Clerk of the Town
 13 of San Anselmo, to which said notice reference is hereby made for
 14 further particulars.

15 Section 7. All persons qualified to vote at municipal elec-
 16 tions in said Town of San Anselmo upon the date of the election
 17 herein provided for shall be qualified to vote upon the proposi-
 18 tion hereby submitted at said special election.

19 Section 8. The ballots to be used at said Special Election
 20 so consolidated with said General Municipal Election shall, in
 21 addition to the other matter required by law to be printed upon
 22 the ballots at such elections so consolidated, including such in-
 23 structions to voters as are required by law, have printed thereon
 24 the following:
