

1 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 212 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE
 2 IMPOSING LICENSE FEES ON BUSINESS, PROFESSIONS, CALLINGS, TRADES,
 3 OR OCCUPATIONS, TRANSACTED OR CARRIED ON WITHIN THE TOWN OF SAN
 4 ANSELMO.


5 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

6 Section 1. A new section, to be known as 4A, is hereby added to
 7 Ordinance No. 212, entitled "An Ordinance Imposing License Fees
 8 on Businesses, Professions, Callings, Trades, or Occupations,
 9 Transacted or carried on within the Town of San Anselmo, said
 10 new section to read as follows:

11 Section 4A. All applications for any ^{new} license to maintain or
 12 operate a junk yard, auto wrecking business, or light manufactur-
 13 ing business, ^{in a Residential or Commercial zone,} shall be made in writing to the City Council of the
 14 Town of San Anselmo. Upon considering any such application the
 15 City Council shall determine whether or not any such business
 16 would constitute a nuisance in the neighborhood in which appli-
 17 cation is made to operate said business, and if in the opinion of
 18 a majority of the City Council such business would so constitute
 19 a nuisance, then the license to operate same shall be refused.
 20 The finding of the City Council shall be binding and conclusive
 21 upon the applicant and all parties.

22 Section 2. within 15 days after its final passage, this ordi-
 23 nance shall be published once in the Marin Herald, a weekly news-
 24 paper of general circulation, published and circulated in said
 25 Town of San Anselmo, and hereby designated for that purpose.
