

ORDINANCE NO. 946

1 AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE SALE OF CERTAIN COMMODITIES BY WEIGHT.

3 The City Council of the Town of San Anselmo does ordain as
4 follows:

5 SECTION ONE: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, part-
6 nership, association, or corporation, conducting any business in
7 the Town of San Anselmo, to advertise, offer for sale, or sell, or
8 to cause or knowingly permit the advertising, offering for sale, or
9 selling of, any smoked, fresh or pickled meat, poultry, rabbit or
10 fish, except shanks, offal, heads, planks and wild game, other than
11 by weight determined on a scale by weight or a beam, properly seal-
12 ed by the Department of Weights & Measures of the State of Califor-
13 nia, and when a sale of any such commodity is made in the presence
14 of the purchaser, then the weighing thereof must likewise be made
15 in the presence of the purchaser.

16 SECTION TWO: Every person, firm, partnership, association or
17 corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall
18 be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall
19 be punished by a fine not to exceed \$200.00 or by imprisonment in
20 the County Jail for not more than three months, or by both such fine
21 and imprisonment.

22 SECTION THREE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in con-
23 flict herewith are hereby repealed.

24 SECTION FOUR: This ordinance shall be published within fifteen
25 (15) days after its final passage once in full in the "San Anselmo
26 Herald," a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated
27 in the Town of San Anselmo, and shall take effect and be in force
28 thirty (30) days from and after its final passage.

29 The foregoing ordinance was duly and regularly introduced at a
30 regular meeting of the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo held
31 in said Town on the 11th day of May, 1937, and was thereafter
32 at a regular meeting of said City Council held in said Town on the
