AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 263 OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CLEANING OF ALL CREEKS OR CHANNELS AND WATERCOURSES OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO; THE REMOVAL OF ALL DEBRIS AND OBSTRUCTIONS THEREFROM; DECLARING ANY OBSTRUCTION TO CREEK OR WATERCOURSE TO BE A PUBLIC NUISANCE, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE" BY THE ADDITION THERETO OF A NEW SECTION 4(a)

The City Council of the Town of San Anselmo does ordain as follows:

Section 1. A new section to be known as 4(a) is hereby added to Ordinance No. 263 of the Town of San Anselmo entitled "An Ordinance Providing for the Cleaning of all Creeks or Channels and Watercourses of the Town of San Anselmo; the Removal of All Debris and Obstructions Therefrom; Declaring any Obstruction to Creek or Watercourse to be a Public Nuisance, and Providing Penalties for Violation of this Ordinance", said new section to read as follows:

Section 4(a) - Before the issuance of any building permit for the erection or construction of any building or structure in the Town of San Anselmo, the Building Inspector shall determine whether or not in his judgment such structure or building would interfere with the free flow of any water in any creek in said town. If in the opinion of said Building Inspector such a building or structure would interfere with the flow of water during any season, the building permit shall not be issued until the applicant or owner of the premises involved has made ample provision, by culvert or otherwise, for the free flow of water in the channel of said creek. The building permit may issue after said provision for flow of water has been completed, or upon the posting of a bond to complete said provision or work within such time and in such an amount as said Building Inspector shall fix.

Section 2. The foregoing ordinance shall, within fifteen (15) days of its final passage and adoption be, published once in the San Anselmo Herald, a weekly newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the Town of San Anselmo, and hereby designated for that purpose, and shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its final passage and adoption.
