AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 212 OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO ENTITLED "ORDINANCE IMPOSING LICENSE FEES ON BUSINESSES, PROFESSIONS, CALLINGS, TRADES OR OCCUPATIONS TRANSACTED OR CARRIED ON WITHIN THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO" BY THE ADDITION THERETO OF THREE NEW SECTIONS TO BE DESIGNATED AS 1(a), 2(a), AND 2(b) RESPECTIVELY.

The City Council of the Town of San Anselmo does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Three new sections to be known as Sections 1(a), 2(a) and 2(b), respectively, are hereby added to Ordinance No. 212, entitled "An Ordinance Imposing License Fees on Businesses, Professions, Callings, Trades or Occupations Transacted or Carried On Within the Town of San Anselmo", said new sections to read as follows:

Section 1(a) - It shall be unlawful for any peddler, solicitor, resident or non-resident merchant, agent, or employee of any such persons, engaging in any part of his business activity in the residential districts of the Town of San Anselmo, to use any horn, whistle, bell, or other noise-making device to signal his approach or presence in such district or neighborhood.

Section 2(a) - It shall be unlawful for any person, whether as principal or agent, owner or employee, to commence, engage in, or transact or carry on the business of selling any personal property, except nursery stock and trees within the commercial or business districts of the Town of San Anselmo, unless said business is conducted in a permanently constructed business building with at least three (3) walls and a roof.

Section 2(b) - It shall be unlawful for any person, whether as principal or agent, owner or employee, to commence, engage in, transact or carry on the business of selling any personal property from any stand, station, vehicle, truck trailer, or any temporary structure upon any private or public property, street or sidewalk, within the commercial or business districts of the Town of San Anselmo.

Section 2. The foregoing ordinance shall, within fifteen (15) days of its final passage and adoption, be published once in the San Anselmo Herald, a weekly newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the Town of San Anselmo, and hereby designated for that purpose, and shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its final passage and adoption.

The foregoing ordinance was duly and regularly introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo held in said town on the 9 day of July, 1946, and was thereafter at a regular meeting of said City Council held in said Town of San Anselmo on the 23 day of July, 1946, duly passed and adopted by the following vote:
