AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 207 OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC UPON THE PUBLIC STREETS OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HERewith" BY THE ADDITION THERETO OF THREE NEW SECTIONS TO BE NUMBERED SECTIONS 32.1, 32.2 and 32.3

The City Council of the Town of San Anselmo does ordain as follows:

Section 1: Ordinance No. 207 of the Town of San Anselmo is hereby amended by the addition thereto of three new sections to be known and designated as Sections 32.1, 32.2 and 32.3, and which said new Sections shall read as follows, to-wit:

Section 32.1: There shall be established, by resolution of the City Council as hereinafter specified, in the "business district" of the Town of San Anselmo, as said district is defined and delineated in this Ordinance, "special parking zones" which said zones will be marked and indicated by painting of the curb immediately adjacent thereto for the full length thereof a green color, and such other markings and signs as may be ordered by the City Council.

Section 32.2: The City Council shall, by resolution, fix and determine the location of "special parking zones" and shall direct the chief of police to appropriately mark such zones, and to paint the curb immediately adjacent thereto, for the full length thereof, a green color.

Section 32.3: Between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. of each day except Sunday, it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to park a vehicle continuously for a longer period than fifteen minutes, in any special parking zone, contrary to any special parking zone sign or curb color marking herein specified.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be published once, within fifteen days after its final passage and adoption, in the San Anselmo Herald, a weekly newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the Town of San Anselmo, and hereby designated for that purpose, and shall be in
