

ORDINANCE NO. 311

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT  
AND OPERATION OF PARKING LOTS IN THE TOWN OF  
SAN ANSELMO

The City Council of the Town of San Anselmo does ordain as follows:

Section 1: The term "parking lot" as used in this Ordinance shall mean and include any parcel or lot of land in San Anselmo used, or improved for use, as a parking space for four or more vehicles, at any one time, during any period of the day, and two or more adjoining or contiguous lots so used shall constitute one parking lot.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for the owner of any land in the Town of San Anselmo to use or operate, or permit the use or operation of his land, by any leasee or other person, as a parking lot, without first obtaining a permit so to do from the Chief of Police. The Chief of Police shall issue any such permit upon application therefor without charge when it has been established that such land is located within the commercial district or the unrestricted district of the Town of San Anselmo as said districts are defined and delineated by Ordinance No. 254 of the Town of San Anselmo, and further that the applicant is the owner of said premises, or is lawfully entitled to possession of them.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person to stop or park any automobile or other vehicle upon the real property of another person in the Town of San Anselmo without the permission, expressed or implied, of the owner or lessee of said real property.

Section 4. It shall be unlawful for the owner or lessee of any land in the Town of San Anselmo, which is located in the First Residential District or the Second Residential District, as said districts are defined in Ordinance No. 254 of the Town of San Anselmo to use or operate, or permit the use or operation, of such land as a parking lot within the meaning of this Ordinance.

Section 5. The Town of San Anselmo may own or lease and operate such public parking lots in the Town of San Anselmo as may be necessary for the convenience of the travelling public.

Section 6. The City Council may, by resolution, adopt such regulations as may be necessary for the use and operation of any public parking lot in the Town of San Anselmo, to include, among other things, the following:

- (a) The marking of said public parking lots into parking spaces with directions for parking of vehicles;
- (b) The price, if any, to be charged for parking;
- (c) The limit of time allowed, if any, for continuous parking;
- (d) The erection of entrance, exit and other directional signs.

Section 7. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle in any publicly owned or operated parking lot in the Town of San Anselmo contrary to the directions of any parking lot sign or pavement marking in said lot. When any time limit for continuous parking has been established for any public parking lot by resolution of the City Council, and notice thereof has been given by a sign posted on said public parking lot, it shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle on said parking lot continuously for a period longer than the time established by said resolution.

Section 8. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by fine, not exceeding \$500.00 or by imprisonment in the County Jail of the County of Marin, State of California for not more than six months, or by both such fine or imprisonment.

Section 9. Copies of this Ordinance shall be posted within fifteen days after its final passage and adoption in three (3) public places in the Town of San Anselmo, to-wit:

- (a) Bulletin Board, San Anselmo Public Library
- (b) Bulletin Board, San Anselmo Post Office
- (c) Bulletin Board, San Anselmo City Hall,

which said places are designated for that purpose and shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its final passage and adoption.

The foregoing Ordinance was duly and regularly introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo, held in said Town on the 8 day of February, 1949, and was thereafter on the 15 day of February, 1949 at a regular meeting of the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo held in said Town duly passed and adopted by the following vote:
