

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION ONE OF ORDINANCE NO. 239
OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO AND AMENDING SAID ORDINANCE
ENTITLED "ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DRUNKENNESS IN PUBLIC
PLACES"

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO DOES ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 239 is hereby repealed
in each and every several part thereof and the whole thereof.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 239 is hereby amended by adding
thereto section 1-a as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person to be drunk
or intoxicated on any public highway or in any public
place or in or about any automobile in a public place
or in any place open to public view in the Town of
San Anselmo.

Section 1-b. It shall be unlawful for any person
to be drunk or intoxicated on any private premises or in
any private house, to the annoyance of any other person,
within the Town of San Anselmo.

Section 2. Any person who shall violate any of
the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a
misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be pun-
ished by a fine not to exceed three hundred (\$300.00)
Dollars, or by imprisonment in the County jail for not
more than three months, or by both such fine and imprison-
ment.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be published once
within fifteen (15) days after its final passage in the
SAN ANSELMO TIMES a weekly newspaper of general publication
and circulation, published and circulated in said Town
of San Anselmo and hereby designated for that purpose.

The foregoing Ordinance was duly and regularly introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo, held in said Town on the 14th day of July, 1953, and was thereafter on the 11th day of August, 1953 at a regular meeting of the City Council of the TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO held in said Town duly passed and adopted by the following vote:
