

TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO ORDINANCE NO. 364

"AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE V, SECTION 30, OF
TRAFFIC ORDINANCE NO. 207 BY PROHIBITING PARKING
ON EITHER SIDE OF CEDAR STREET BETWEEN TUNSTEAD
AVENUE AND TAMALPAIS AVENUE.

WHEREAS, contracts have been let for the paving of Cedar Street between Tunstead Avenue and Tamalpais Avenue, and

WHEREAS, gasoline tax funds will be used for the payment of the said contract price, and

WHEREAS, as a condition to the use of said gasoline tax funds for said payment, the California State Division of Highways has recommended that due to the width of said proposed Cedar Street parking on either side be prohibited, now therefore
THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO DOES ORDAIN AS
FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 30, Article V of Ordinance No. 207 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection (5) to read as follows:

(5) On either side of Cedar Street between Tunstead Avenue and Tamalpais Avenue.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days from and after its final passage.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be published once within fifteen (15) days after its passage in the San Anselmo Times a weekly newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the Town of San Anselmo which said newspaper is hereby designated for that purpose.

The above and foregoing ordinance was read and introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo held on Tuesday, June 15, 1954, and was thereafter at a adjourned meeting held by the City Council on the 22nd day of June 1954, duly passed and adopted by the following vote:
