AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 16(a) OF ZONING
ORDINANCE NO. 254 BY INCREASING THE FEE FOR
REZONING AND PROVIDING FOR A FEE FOR USE PERMIT
APPLICATIONS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO DOES
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 16(a) of Ordinance No. 254 is
hereby amended to read as follows:

16(a) The verified petition of one or more
owners of property affected by the proposed amendment, which
petition shall be filed with the Planning Commission and shall
be accompanied by a fee of fifty (\$50.00) dollars, no part
of which shall be returnable to the petitioner; such petition
shall be accompanied by a map or diagram showing the boundaries
of the property or area desired to be affected or re-classified,
and showing, all property and the owners thereof within a radius
of 250 feet from the exterior boundaries of said property sought
to be changed or affected; any application for a use permit shall
be accompanied by a fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00),
no part of which shall be returnable to the applicant; or by

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective thirty
(30) days from and after its final passage.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be published once within
fifteen (15) days after its passage in the SAN ANSELMO TIMES, a
weekly newspaper of general circulation published and circulated
in the Town of San Anselmo which said newspaper is hereby designated
for that purpose.

duced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the Town of
