AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 403,
THE USE TAX ORDINANCE, BY REPEALING SECTIONS
12(a) THEREOF PROVIDING FOR EXEMPTIONS FROM
USE TAX FOR PURCHASES MADE BY THE STATE OF
CALIFORNIA OR BY ANY AGENCY, DEPARTMENT,
POLITICAL SUBDIVISION, DISTRICT OR MUNICIPAL
CORPORATION THEREOF.

The City Council of the City of San Anselmo do
ordain as follows:

Section 1. Sections 12(a) and 12(b)
are hereby repealed, and on and after the first day of
January, 1957 the use tax under Ordinance No. 403 shall
be imposed on the ~~United States Government, the~~ ^{any} State of California, or by ^{any} agency,
department, political subdivision, district or municipal
corporation thereof.

Section 2. This ordinance, inasmuch as it provides
for a tax levy for the usual current expenses of the City,
shall, under the provisions of Section I of Article IV of
the Constitution, take effect immediately, provided, how-
ever, the imposition of the tax referred to in Section 1.
hereof shall become effective on January 1, 1957.

Section 3. PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall be
published once in full within fifteen days from and after
its final passage in the ROSS VALLEY TIMES, a weekly newspaper
printed, published and circulated in the City of San Anselmo,
and hereby designated for that purpose.

The foregoing ordinance was duly and regularly intro-
duced at a regular adjourned meeting of the City Council at
the City of San Anselmo held in said city on the 20th day
of November, 1956, and was thereafter on the 11th day of
