ORDINANCE NO. 430

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 410, THE
BUSINESS LICENSING ORDINANCE, BY CHANGING
CERTAIN LICENSE RATES OF VARIOUS BUSINESS
CLASSIFICATIONS.

The Council of the City of San Anselmo does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 410 of the City of San Anselmo is hereby amended as follows:

(a) That part of Section 19.2 immediately following the colon after the work "therefor" to the colon after the word "follows" is amended to read as follows: provided, however, that in cases of a new business where the license imposed is FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) or more per year, the license charge shall be pro-rated according to the commencement date of such new business as follows:

(b) Section 22.1 is hereby repealed and a new Section 22.1 is substituted for the said repealed section as follows:

22.1 RETAIL STORES AND OUTLETS

Every person transacting or carrying on any retail business other than and excepting those businesses enumerated in Sections 24 to 49 inclusive, shall pay an annual license tax of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00)

(c) The license of THIRTY DOLLARS (\$30.00) imposed by Section 24 and subsections thereof is amended to read TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00).

(d) The license of FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) imposed by Section 25, and subsections thereof, is amended to read TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00).

(e) The words "Agent or" of Section 25.1 No. 42 are hereby deleted.

(f) Section 25.¹ No. 67 is hereby deleted in its entirety.

(g) Section 26.1 ^(b) ~~2~~ is hereby deleted in its entirety.

(h) The license of FIFTEEN DOLLARS (\$15.00) imposed by Section 31, and subsections thereof, is amended to read TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00).

(i) The license of THIRTY DOLLARS (\$30.00) imposed by Section 33, and subsections thereof, is hereby amended to read TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00).

(j) The license of FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) imposed by Section 37, and subsections thereof, is hereby amended to read TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00).

(k) The license of FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) imposed by Section 38, and subsections thereof, is hereby amended to read TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00).

(l) The license of FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) imposed by Section 40, and subsections thereof, is hereby amended to read TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00).

(m) Section 43 and subsections thereof are hereby amended as follows:

1. After the word "Peddlers" in the title there are added the words "and Solicitors and/or Order Takers".

2. A new subsection numbered 43.5 is hereby added to Section 43 as follows:

Every person carrying on, conducting, or transacting the business of a solicitor and/or order taker shall pay an annual license fee

of FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00).

(n) The license of THIRTY DOLLARS (\$30.00) imposed by Section 44, and subsections thereof, is hereby amended to read FIFTEEN DOLLARS (\$15.00).

(o) The license of FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) imposed by Section 46, and subsections thereof, is hereby amended to read TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00).

(p) The license of TWENTY DOLLARS (\$20.00) imposed by Section 47, subsection 47.1, is hereby amended to read TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00).

(q) The license of TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) imposed by Section 47, subsection 47.2, is hereby amended to read FIFTEEN DOLLARS (\$15.00).

(r) The license of FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) imposed by Section 49, and subsections thereof, is hereby amended to read TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00).

Section 2. Repeal: ~~Ordinance No. 410 and all ordinances amendatory thereof, and~~ All other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Effective Date: This ordinance, inasmuch as it provides for a license tax levy for the usual current expenses of the City, shall take effect immediately upon final passage and adoption, provided, however, the imposition of the license taxes shall take effect on the first day of January, 1958.

Section 4. Publication: This ordinance shall be published once in full, within fifteen days from and after its final passage and adoption, in the ROSS VALLEY TIMES, a weekly newspaper of general circulation, printed, published and circulated in the City of San Anselmo, which said newspaper is hereby designated for that purpose.

The foregoing ordinance was duly and regularly introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council at the City of San Anselmo, held in the City Hall, on the 12th day of November, 1957, and was thereafter at a regular meeting of the City Council duly passed and adopted by the following vote:
