ORDINANCE NO. 447

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORD. NO. 207, COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE "TRAFFIC ORDINANCE" BY ADDING TO ARTICLE IV THEREOF A NEW SECTION DESIGNATED AS SECTION 22A PROVIDING A WEIGHT LIMIT FOR VEHICLES ON CENTER BOULEVARD FROM THE FAIRFAX CITY LIMITS TO SAN RAFAEL AVE. IN THE CITY OF SAN ANSELMO.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANSELMO DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 207 of the City of San

Anselmo is hereby amended by adding to Article IV thereof a new section to be known as Section 22A to read as follows:

22A. Center Boulevard, also sometimes known as Railroad Ave., from the Fairfax City limits to San Rafael Ave., in the City of San Anselmo is hereby designated as weight limit street and no vehicle exceeding a maximum gross weight of three (3) tons (including the vehicle and load) shall be operated on said street at any time.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is adopted pursuant to Section 713 of the California Vehicle Code and applies to all vehicles save and except as to such vehicles which are exempt by virtue of the provisions of Section 713.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an urgency measure and is to take effect immediately upon its final passage and adoption subject to posting of appropriate signs designating the weight limit. That the facts constituting the emergency are as follows:

Center Boulevard originally was a railroad right of way for maintenance of tracks and as such the base material is inadequate for the maintenance of vehicles having a total weight in excess of three (3) tons. Unless restricted said Boulevard will immediately be used by extremely heavy construction vehicles which will inevitably cause extensive damage to said Boulevard making the same dangerous and causing unnecessary expense to the City by way of repairs. That said damage during the rainy season could conceivably result in a situation where the entire street would eventually have to be reconstructed. That, therefore, public convenience, necessity, welfare and safety require this ordinance to be effective immediately.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be published once, within fifteen days of its final passage and adoption, in the Ross Valley Times, a weekly newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of San Anselmo, and hereby designated for that purpose.

The foregoing Ordinance was introduced at a regular adjourned meeting of the City Council of the City of San Anselmo, held in said City on the 22nd day of October, 1958, and was thereafter on the 22nd day of October, 1958, at a regular adjourned meeting of the City Council of the City of San Anselmo held in said City, duly passed and adopted by the following vote:
