ORDINANCE NO. 540

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3, CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 1, OF THE SAN ANSELMO MUNICIPAL CODE BY PROVIDING NEW FIRE ZONES AND ESTABLISHING AN OFFICIAL MAP DESIGNATED "OFFICIAL FIRE ZONE MAP" ON WHICH ALL FUTURE FIRE ZONE CHANGES WILL BE DELINEATED.

The City Council of the City of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Title 3, Chapter 3, Article 1, of the San Anselmo Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"3-3.101. There is hereby adopted the fire zone map of the City of San Anselmo, prepared by the City Engineer, which map shall be known as the "Official Fire Zone Map" and shall have affixed thereto the number of this ordinance and the date of its passage and adoption. As so adopted the fire zones in the City of San Anselmo shall, after this ordinance is passed and adopted, conform to the fire zone classifications as shown on said map. Fire Zone 1 shall be all that part of San Anselmo shown on the official fire zone map bounded and delineated by a red line. Fire Zone 2 shall be all that part of San Anselmo shown on the official fire zone map bounded and delineated by a brown line. Fire Zone 3 shall be all the remainder of the City of San Anselmo not delineated in red or brown."

"3-3.102. Hereafter whenever real property is rezoned by ordinance from R-1 to any use other than single family residential the fire zone shall, by reason of such rezoning, become Fire Zone 2 and no proceedings, resolutions or ordinances shall be required or necessary to effect the fire zone change. When any parcel of land is rezoned the Official Fire Zone Map shall be revised and amended to reflect the newly created fire zoning."

"3-3.103. Fire Zone amendments and changes, except those inherently a part of a rezoneing, shall be made by ordinance and thereafter the Official Fire Zone Map shall be amended to properly reflect the change or amendment."

"3-3.104. It shall be the duty of the City Engineer to keep the Official Fire Zone Map properly maintained and available for public inspection during all usual business days."

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published once in full within fifteen (15) days from and after its passage and adoption in the Independent Journal, a daily newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the ~~City of San Anselmo~~, and County of Marin, and said ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its final passage and adoption.

The foregoing ordinance was duly and regularly introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of San Anselmo, held in said City on the 25 day of October, 1966, and was thereafter at a regular meeting of said City Council, held in said City on the 22 day of November, 1966, duly passed and adopted by the following vote:
