CITY OF SAN ANSELMO

ORDINANCE NO. 567

AN ORDINANCE ADDING CHAPTER ⁶~~4~~, TO TITLE 2 OF THE SAN ANSELMO MUNICIPAL CODE DECLARING AND DESIGNATING THAT THE FIRE CHIEF, ASSISTANT FIRE CHIEF, DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS, CITY ENGINEER, STREET SUPERINTENDENT, CHIEF BUILDING OFFICIAL, BUILDING INSPECTOR AND ZONING ADMINISTRATOR ARE PEACE OFFICERS FOR CERTAIN LIMITED PURPOSES AND AS SUCH ARE FURTHER DESIGNATED AND APPOINTED AS RESERVE POLICE OFFICERS.

The City Council of the City of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Chapter ⁶~~4~~ is hereby added to Title 2 of the San Anselmo Municipal Code as follows:

"2-⁶~~4~~.01. The following public employees and officers of the City of San Anselmo are hereby designated as Peace Officers, pursuant to section 817 of the Penal Code of the State of California, and as such are hereby appointed as Reserve Police Officers for the limited and restricted law enforcement purposes as more particularly set forth in this ordinance.

"(a) Fire Chief, Francis A. Sousa or his successor or successors, to administer and enforce, by arrest, the violators of Title 3, Chapter 3, of the San Anselmo Municipal Code.

"(b) Assistant Fire Chief, Richard McLaren, his successor or successors, to administer and enforce, by arrest, the violators of Title 3, Chapter 3, of the San Anselmo Municipal Code.

"(c) Director of Public Works; City Engineer; Street Superintendent; Chief Building Official, Charles R. Leitzel, his successor or successors as to each designated

and respective office, to administer and enforce, by arrest, the violators of the San Anselmo Municipal Code as follows:

- (1) Title 3, Chapter 3, Article 6,
- (2) Title 4, Chapters 9 and 13,
- (3) Title 5, Chapters 2 and 4,
- (4) Title 6, Chapter 3,
- (5) Title 7,
- (6) Title 9, and
- (7) Title 10.

"(d) Building Inspector; Zoning Administrator, Robert Golcher, his successor or successors as to each designated office, to administer and enforce, by arrest, the violators of the San Anselmo Municipal Code as follows:

- (1) Title 5, Chapters 2 and 4,
- (2) Title 9,
- (3) Title 10, Chapters 3 and 4.

"2-⁶~~4~~.02. The public employees and officers designated in the foregoing section when performing their duties as a Peace Officer shall not be required to wear any distinctive police uniform but shall carry on their person a badge or other appropriate credential showing their authority as a Peace Officer.

"2-⁶~~4~~.03. Whenever any of the public employees and officers named in this Chapter are performing duties as a Police Officer such employee or officer shall be under the general administration of the Chief of Police and

shall report to him in such form and in such manner as the Chief of Police shall direct.

"2-⁶/~~4~~.04. As used in this Chapter the word "arrest" shall not mean the usual formal arrest procedure but is limited to the issuance of a citation for misdemeanor pursuant to section 853.6 of the Penal Code of the State of California. If the violator does not accept a citation and demands to be taken before a magistrate then the necessary arrest shall be made by a regular uniformed Police Officer."

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published once in full within fifteen (15) days from and after its passage and adoption in the Independent Journal, a daily newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of San Anselmo, and County of Marin, and said ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its final passage and adoption.

The foregoing ordinance was duly and regularly introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of San Anselmo, held in said City on the 11th day of June, 1968, and was thereafter at a regular meeting of said City Council, held in said City on the 25th day of June, 1968, duly passed and adopted by the following vote:
