ORDINANCE NO. 601

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE CONSOLIDATED WITH THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 1970, IN THE CITY OF SAN ANSELMO FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING MEASURES TO THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANSELMO.

The City Council of the City of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A special municipal election is hereby called to be consolidated with the general election to be held in the City of San Anselmo on Tuesday, November 3, 1970, for the purpose of submitting to the electors of the City of San Anselmo the following propositions.

(a) Proposition A. Shall the City of San Anselmo purchase a new fire engine including its necessary related apparatus and equipment at a cost of FIFTY-TWO THOUSAND (\$52,000.00) DOLLARS by levying a special tax, pursuant to Government Code section 43225, of nine cents (.09) on each one hundred dollars (\$100) on the property assessed for purpose of taxation within the City for the two fiscal years of 1971-1972 and 1972-1973.

(b) Proposition B. Shall the City of San Anselmo undertake the needed reconstruction and upgrading of certain City streets (as shown by the report of the Director of Public Works) at a total cost of FIFTY-TWO-THOUSAND (\$52,000.00) DOLLARS by levying a special tax, pursuant to Government Code section 43225, of nine cents (.09) on each one hundred dollars (\$100) on the property assessed for purposes of taxation within the City for the fiscal years 1971-1972 and 1972-1973.

(c) Proposition C. Shall the present salaries of each of the San Anselmo City Councilmen of TWENTY-FIVE (\$25.00) DOLLARS per each monthly meeting attended with a maximum of SEVENTY-FIVE (\$75.00) DOLLARS per month be reduced so as to limit the monthly salary to a maximum of FIFTY (\$50.00) DOLLARS.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published once in full, within fifteen (15) days of its final passage and adoption in The Reporter, a newspaper published and of general circulation in the City of San Anselmo.


Section 3. This ordinance relates to an election and pursuant to section 36937 of the Government Code of the State of California shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.


