

TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO

ORDINANCE NO. 806

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE UNDERGROUND INSTALLATION OF ELECTRIC AND COMMUNICATION UTILITY SERVICE ON PORTIONS OF SIR FRANCIS DRAKE BLVD., BRIDGE AVE. AND CENTER BLVD. BETWEEN SYCAMORE AVE. AND RED HILL AVE.

The Town Council of the Town of San Anselmo does ordain as follows:

Chapter 8 of Title 7 of the San Anselmo Municipal Code is hereby amended to add the following sections:

Section 7-8.15

(a) A public hearing held in the manner and within the time required by law has been given to all affected property owners (as shown on the last equalized assessment roll) and to all affected utilities on whether underground installation of electric and communication utility service shall be required on portions of Sir Francis Drake Blvd., Bridge Ave. and Center Blvd. between Sycamore Ave. and Red Hill Ave. in the Town of San Anselmo.

(b) The Town Council, on conclusion of the public hearing aforesaid, finds and determines that public necessity, health, safety, and welfare require the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures; and the installation of underground facilities for supplying electric, communication and similar or associated service by the establishment of an underground utility district on portions of Sir Francis Drake Blvd., Bridge Ave. and Center Blvd. between Sycamore Ave. and Red Hill Ave. for the following reasons:

(1) Such undergrounding will eliminate an unusually heavy concentration of overhead distribution facilities;

(2) The area involved is extensively used by the general

public and carries heavy volumes of vehicular and pedestrian traffic;

(3) The Hub Bus Transfer Facility project will extend Creek Park along the southerly side of Center Blvd., within the area proposed for undergrounding.

(c) The area on Sir Francis Drake Blvd., Bridge Ave. and Center Blvd. between Sycamore Ave. and Red Hill Ave. is hereby declared to be an Underground Utility District and is designated as Underground Utility District No. 4 of the Town of San Anselmo. Attached, marked Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein, is a map delineating the boundaries of said District.

(d) The Council hereby fixes October 1, 1981 as the date on which affected property owners must be ready to receive underground service. The underground installation of facilities for supplying electric, communication and similar or associated service within Underground Utility District No. 4 must be completed on or before October 1, 1981. The removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures must be completed by March 1, 1982.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced at a regular meeting of the San Anselmo Town Council held on May 26, 1981, and was thereafter at a regular meeting of the Town Council held on the 9th day of June, 1981, duly passed and adopted by the following vote:


