

RESOLUTION NO. 622

RESOLUTION DETERMINING PREVAILING RATE OF PER DIEM
WAGES FOR VARIOUS CRAFTSMEN, TRUCK DRIVERS, AND OTHER
WORKERS IN AND FOR THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO, CALIFORNIA

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo, California, that notwithstanding any and all prior resolutions of similar tenor and effect, said City Council does hereby determine the prevailing rate of per diem wages in and for the locality of San Anselmo, California, for the following crafts or employments engaged in or performing public work in said Town, and in the following amounts, to-wit:

Concrete Pan Work, Magnesite and Mastic Workers (wet or dry), Sloper) Mucker-Underground, Pavement Breakers, Jackhammer-Vibrator and all air, gas, and electric tools, loading and unloading, Carrying and Handling of all rods and material for use in re-enforcing, concrete construction, Asphalt Ironers and Rakers, Concrete and Magnesite Mixer under 1/2 yard.

Group III: 1.85

General Labor, Gardeners and Landscape Laborers, Bridge Laborers, Construction Laborers, All cleanup work of debris, grounds, and buildings, Watchmen, Flagmen and Guards, Wrecking Laborers, Maintenance and Repair Trackmen, Street-car and Railroad Construction Track Laborers, Asphalt Shovelers, Concrete Laborers (wet or dry).

LATHERS:

Journeyman 3.00
Foremen (not less than \$1.00 per day over journeymen's rate)

PAINTERS:

The minimum rate of pay for journeymen painters, decorators, paperhangers, building washers, sand blasters, sheet-rock tapers, and all other branches of the trade under the jurisdiction of the Brotherhood of Painters, Decorators and Paperhangers of America, Inc., shall be Two Dollars and Sixty Cents per hr. (\$2.60)
Foremen (not less than \$1.00 per day over journeymen's rate)

PLASTERERS:

Journeyman 3.275
Foremen (not less than \$1.00 per day above journeymen's rate)
Hodcarriers (\$2.75 for 8 hrs).

PLUMBERS, STEAMFITTERS & PIPEFITTERS:

Journeyman 3.00
Foremen (not less than \$2.00 per day above journeymen's rate)

ROOFERS, DAMP & WATERPROOF WORKERS:

Journeyman 2.65
Foremen (not less than \$1.00 per day above journeymen's rate)

SHEET METAL WORKERS:

Journeyman 2.625
Foremen (not less than \$1.00 per day above journeymen's rate)


