RESOLUTION NO. 687

RESOLUTION CHANGING THE NAMES OF CERTAIN STREETS  
TOWIT: RAILROAD AVENUE; JERSEY ROAD; PORTION OF  
CYPRESS ROAD; MARIUS AVENUE; JORDAN COURT; GROVE  
HILL AVENUE;  
ALSO NAMING NEW STREETS TOWIT: WILLOW WAY;  
GREENFIELD COURT; AND A PORTION OF FORMER RAILROAD  
PROPERTY FROM RED HILL AVENUE SOUTHERLY TO BOLINAS  
AVENUE.

Good cause appearing therefor, and it being found that public convenience and welfare require the changing of names and designations of certain streets and naming new streets in the City of San Anselmo,

Now therefore be it resolved and ordered that the following changes in street names are the new official names of the following enumerated streets, towit:

- 1) Railroad Avenue, from westerly line of Sir Francis Drake Boulevard to Fairfax City limits, - to Center Boulevard
- 2) Jersey Road - to The Alameda
- 3) Cypress Road, southerly from Crooked Avenue to its intersection with Knoll Road, to Knoll Road.
- 4) Marius Avenue, together with portions of Lots 11 and 12, Block 4, Cordone Tract (deeded for street purposes) to Brookside Drive
- 5) Jordan Court - to Oak Hill Drive
- 6) Grove Hill Avenue to Grove Hill Avenue North and Grove Hill Avenue South, (being a recorded street in the Map of Sequoia Park Subdivision No. 2 and running both North and South from Sequoia Drive and both being dead-end streets.

It is further Resolved and ordered that certain new streets be officially named as follows:

- 1) Greenfield Court, being a short dead-end street unnamed on the recorded Map of San Rafael Heights Subdivision on the Southerly side of Greenfield Avenue about 200 feet southeasterly from the intersection of Sequoia Drive and Greenfield Avenue.
- 2) Willow Way, being a short dead-end street on the easterly side of Butterfield Road opposite Fairview Court.
- 3) Sir Francis Drake Boulevard, being that former railroad property and right of way already acquired by the City or to be acquired in the future extending from the westerly line Red Hill Avenue intersection southerly to Bolinas Avenue.

It is further resolved and ordered that a copy of this Resolution certified under seal by the City Clerk shall be delivered to the Board of Supervisors of the County of Marin, pursuant to section 34092 of the Government Code, and also to the Postmaster of the City of San Anselmo.
