RESOLUTION NO. 763

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND ORDERING THE CONDEMNATION
OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY REPUTED TO BE OWNED BY
DANIEL N. SAPP AND HILDEGARDE V. SAPP, IN THE CITY OF
SAN ANSELMO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, the public convenience and necessity require the acquisition of the hereinafter described real property for the purpose of constructing thereon a sub-station for the Fire Department of the City of San Anselmo.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Anselmo, and the City Council does hereby find and declare as follows, to wit:

1. That the public interest and necessity require the acquisition of the hereinafter described real property for the purpose of constructing thereon a sub-station for the Fire Department of the City of San Anselmo.

2. That it is hereby found necessary, and the City Council does hereby resolve that all of that said hereinafter described property is necessary to be taken for the purposes hereinabove set forth, and is required as aforesaid by the public interest and necessity.

3. That the following is a particular description of all that certain real property situate in the City of San Anselmo, County of Marin, State of California, described as follows:

LOTS 88, 90 and 92 of "Short Ranch, Subdivision One, Marin County, Calif.," recorded May 9, 1912 in Volume 4 of Maps, at page 19, Marin County Records.

4. That the use for which said property is to be taken is necessary for the function of the City of San Anselmo as a city of the sixth class, and the taking thereof is

authorized by law, and that all of said land is to be used for the purposes hereinabove mentioned.

5. That the City Attorney be, and he is hereby, ordered and directed to forthwith prepare and file on behalf of the City of San Anselmo, a municipal corporation, an action in the Superior Court of the State of California in and for the County of Marin, to condemn all of the hereinabove described property for the public use and purposes hereinabove set forth, to wit: For the purpose of constructing thereon a sub-station for the Fire Department of the City of San Anselmo, and the City Engineer of the City of San Anselmo is hereby authorized and directed to sign and verify said complaint, and said City Engineer and said City Attorney are authorized and directed and empowered to do any and all other acts and things necessary to complete the condemnation of the hereinabove described lands, to the end that the City of San Anselmo, a municipal corporation, shall own the said property described as aforesaid in fee simple absolute.

The foregoing Resolution was duly passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of San Anselmo held in said City on the 12th day of November, 1958, and passed by the following vote:
