RESOLUTION ADOPTING SCALE OF PREVAILING WAGES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Anselmo, County of Marin, California, did upon the 15th day of July, 1959, adopt plans and specifications for the construction of improvements in Assessment District No. 1959-1, City of San Anselmo, County of Marin, State of California;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Anselmo that said City Council has determined and established the general prevailing rate of per diem wages for each type of craft or workman needed to execute or perform the necessary work or improvement in accordance with the schedule appended hereto and described "Schedule of Per Diem Wage Rates"; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said "Schedule of Per Diem Wage Rates" be embodied in the Notice Inviting Sealed Bids and all contract documents in connection with said work and improvement hereinabove described.
