RESOLUTION NO. 955

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FEES FOR ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS  
IN THE CITY OF SAN ANSELMO IN ACCORDANCE WITH ORDINANCE NO. 490  
OF THE CITY OF SAN ANSELMO.

WHEREAS, on June 11th, 1963, Ordinance No. 490 of the City  
of San Anselmo was passed and adopted by the City Council, which ordinance  
adopts by reference the NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE, 1962 Edition, as the  
Electrical Code for the City of San Anselmo; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance provides for the adoption of a schedule of fees  
by resolution of the City Council upon the passing and adoption of Ordinance  
No. 490 and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 490 has now been duly passed and adopted;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE Schedule of Fees for Electrical  
Installations shall be as set forth in Table 2-A, 1963, attached hereto,  
and made a part of this resolution, and said schedule shall become effective  
when Ordinance No. 490 becomes effective, and shall remain in full force  
and effect until a superseding schedule of fees is adopted and becomes  
effective.

1.	Permits, issuing and filing, each . . . . .	\$ 2.00
2.	Branch circuits and feeders, each . . . . .	.25
3.	Outlets of not more than 1,000 watts rated capacity for lighting power, signaling, or other purposes, and for which fees are not herein specifically prescribed, each . . . . .	.10
4.	Outlets of more than 1,000 watts rated capacity same as above, each . . . . .	.20
5.	Outlets, including attached receptacles, when installed not more than 24 inches apart, for border, strip, or footlighting, or for outline, decorative, display or group lighting (exclusive of sign lighting installed on sheet metal raceways, for which see item 21), each . . . . .	.05
6.	Lighting fixtures, brackets, pendants, cord drops, and other lamp holding devices when not herein specifically classified, each . . . . .	.15
7.	Switches and receptacles, when not attached to or included with apparatus for which fee is herein specifically classified, each . . . . .	.10
8.	Outlets, including attached receptacles, for temporary festoon or decorative lighting, each . . . . .	.02
9.	Fee for temporary construction pole and attached wiring . . . . .	1.50
10.	Services or Service Change:

	Services over 600 volts, over 200 KVA . . . . .	25.00
	Services 600 volts or less:

11.	Domestic ranges, dryers, combination washer and dryer, or water heater installation . . . . .	2.00

The above fees will apply to the receptacle outlet when provided.

12. Heaters (air, water, and other kinds, except as provided for in item 11, above), furnaces and welding machines, each as follows:
- For each KW or KVA and fraction of either . . . . . \$ .20
- Maximum charge for any one unit . . . . . 20.00
13. For inspection of alterations and changes in existing wiring, each inspection visit . . . . . 2.00
14. Motors, including starting and controlling apparatus therefor and wiring between same and motor, each as follows:
- For each rated HP and fraction thereof up to and including 10 HP . . . . . .50
- For each HP and fraction thereof by which the rating of the motor exceeds 10 HP . . . . . .15
- Maximum charge for any one unit as above . . . . . 20.00
- In the instances of changes, renewals, or replacement of said apparatus, where no change in wiring is necessary, the fee for connecting up only shall be charged: per HP at one-half of above amount.
15. Motor generator sets, balancer sets, dynamotors, and converters, including control apparatus, fee of 50% higher than for motors with a maximum for one machine of . . . . . 20.00
16. Generators, including switchboard and controlling apparatus therefor and wiring between same and generator, each as follows:
- For each rated KW or KVA and fraction of either . . . . . .25
- Maximum charge for any one unit . . . . . 20.00
17. Transformers and balance coils, when not embodied in or included with apparatus for which fee is herein specifically prescribed each as follows:
- For each rated KVA and fraction thereof . . . . . .20
- Maximum charge for any one bank . . . . . 50.00
18. Motion picture machines, including operating motor, if any, each . . . . . 1.50
19. Arc lamps, stereoptican lamps, vapor lamps, flood lighting projectors, and spot lights, each . . . . . .25
20. Rectifiers (mercury arc, vibrating and electrolytic each as follows:
- For each KW or KVA and fraction of either . . . . . .25
- Maximum charge for any one unit . . . . . 20.00

21. Signs:

- (a) Electric self-contained signs, initially installed bearing Underwriters' label of approval . . . . . \$ 1.50
- (b) For relocation or alteration of any sign electrically or mechanically, but not including replacement of tubing, transformers, and such parts subject to failure; or for shop inspection department in lieu of a UL label (a local electrical inspection department label of approval shall be required). . . . . 2.00
- (c) Tube lighting for illumination, display or outline . . . . . 1.00  
Plus \$0.25 for each transformer.
- (d) Incandescent lamps for illumination, display or outline lighting having sign receptacles mounted within a sheet metal raceway approved for the purpose . . . . . 1.00  
Plus \$0.01 for each receptacle.

(If constructed of self-contained units which are completed in the shop and bear the Underwriters' label of approval, above does not apply. See 21 (a) for fee charges.)

22. When extra inspections are made necessary by reason of deficient or defective work, or otherwise through fault or error on the part of the holder of the permit, or on the part of his employees, after notice has been given in writing by the Electrical Inspector setting forth the violation, only one such extra inspection shall be made under the regular fees as herein prescribed; and for each and every further extra visit of inspection for which the holder of the permit or his employee is entirely responsible, fees shall be charged as follows:

- \$1.00 for the first such inspection.
- \$2.00 for the second inspection.
- \$5.00 for each additional such inspection.

The Inspection Division shall allow for correction of such work - a minimum period of ten working days following date of inspection.
