RESOLUTION NO. 1185

A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO ABANDON
A PORTION OF LOMA ROBLES DRIVE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Anselmo finds that the hereinafter described portion of public right-of-way is not presently needed for any public use and no public use therefor will be required in the future and that said portion of right-of-way is surplus to the present and prospective needs of the public, except as to public utilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is resolved as follows:

1. That pursuant to the provisions of section 8300 et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code, the City Council declares its intention to abandon and vacate the following described portion of Loma Robles Drive in the City of San Anselmo:

All that portion of Loma Robles Drive, as shown upon the map entitled, "Amended Map of a portion of Map of Loma Robles, San Anselmo, California", filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Marin on December 31, 1965 in Map Book 13 at page 52, LYING SOUTHEASTERLY OF THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED LINE:

BEGINNING at the most Northern corner of Sector "M"; thence North 28° 05' East, 20.00 feet to the Southwestern corner of Lot 5 within Sector "F", as said Sectors and Lot are shown upon the map hereinabove referred to.

2. That reference is made to a map on file in the office of the City Clerk which map delineates the area to be vacated.

3. That a public hearing on the proposed vacation will be held at 8:00 p.m., Tuesday, February 27, 1968, at the Council Chambers in the San Anselmo City Hall at which time and place all persons interested for or against said vacation will be heard.

4. This resolution shall be published once in full in the ^{REPORTER} ~~Independent Journal~~, a newspaper of general circulation

published in the County of Marin, within fifteen (15) days of its passage.

5. Notices of street vacation shall be posted conspicuously along the line of the street proposed to be vacated at least ten (10) days of the said public hearing. Said notices shall be at least three (3) in number and shall be posted not more than three hundred (300) feet apart. The said posted notice shall state the passage of the resolution of intention and the time and place of the public hearing.

6. That this proposed abandonment pertains only as to street purposes and is not intended to nor is it to be construed as an abandonment of any easement for public utilities. Therefore this proposed abandonment excepts and reserves therefrom, pursuant to the provisions of Section 8330 of the Streets and Highways Code, the permanent easement and right at any time, or from time to time, to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, and renew sanitary sewers and storm drains and appurtenant structures in, upon, over and across any street or part thereof proposed to be vacated and to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew and enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles and other convenient structures, equipment, and fixtures for the operation of telegraphic and telephone lines, for the transportation or distribution of electric energy, and for the transportation or distribution of water, including access and the right to keep the property free from inflammable materials, and wood growth, and otherwise protect the same from all hazards in, upon and over ~~the~~ ^{the} street right of way described in 1. above.
