RESOLUTION NO. 1407

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
PROVIDING FOR HOLIDAYS FOR CERTAIN  
EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN ANSELMO

1. GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR, it is hereby declared that the following days are the official holidays for the City of San Anselmo:

- (a) January 1st.
- (b) February 12th., known as "Lincoln Day"
- (c) The third Monday in February
- (d) The last Monday in May
- (e) July 4th.
- (f) First Monday in September
- (g) September 9th., known as "Admission Day"
- (h) The fourth Monday in October, known as "Veterans Day"
- (i) The Thursday in November designated by the President of the United States to be "Thanksgiving Day"
- (j) The Friday after Thanksgiving Day
- (k) December 25th.
- (l) Every Sunday and Saturday

2. If January 1st., February 12th., July 4th., September 9th., or December 25th. falls on a Sunday, the Monday following is a holiday.


3. December 24th. (Christmas Eve) and December 31st. (New Year's Eve) are half holidays, beginning at one o'clock p.m. when these days fall on days other than Saturday or Sunday.

4. The provisions of this Resolution apply to all full-time and part-time employees occupying regular year-round positions and to employees under the Emergency Employment Act. Seasonal and substitute or extra temporary employees are excluded.

5. These holidays do not apply to the Police and Fire Department. The regular full-time employees of the Police and Fire Departments (including Police Clerk-Dispatchers) will receive a day's pay in lieu of each of the above holidays except when the holidays fall on Saturday and are not a holiday for other employees.

6. Any Resolution in conflict with this Resolution is hereby rescinded.

7. This Resolution is passed and adopted pursuant to the authority granted to cities under Section 6702 of the Government Code.


