Resolution No. 1408

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF ELECTRICAL PERMIT FEES TO TAKE EFFECT UPON THE ADOPTION OF THE 1971 EDITION OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Anselmo has adopted the 1971 edition of the National Electrical Code of the National Fire Protection Association (subject to certain amendments and additions), and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish a schedule of Electrical Permit fees,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the following schedule of Electrical Permit Fees be, and the same is hereby adopted, effective thirty (30) days from and after final adoption of the 1971 National Electrical Code:

ELECTRICAL PERMIT FEES: Before any permit required by this ordinance is issued, the applicant therefor shall pay to the City of San Anselmo the fee prescribed herein.

Where work for which a permit is required is started or proceeded with prior to obtaining said permit, the fees herein specified shall be doubled, but the payment of such double fee shall not relieve any persons from fully complying with the requirements of this ordinance in the execution of the work nor from any other penalties prescribed herein.

Fee Schedule

For each additional 100 amp. capacity or fraction thereof-----	1.00
Additional meters and feeders, each-----	.75
Service over 600 volts, first 200 KVA-----	10.00
over 200 KVA-----	25.00
For motors 1 HP or fraction thereof-----	1.00

For motors over 1 HP up to and including 10 HP-	\$1.00 plus .50 per HP	
For motors over 10 HP-----	6.00 plus .20 per HP	
Maximum HP fee-----		25.00
For each motor generator set or frequency change the fee charged shall be 50% greater than that for motors alone.		
For each electrical sign-----		2.50
For swimming pools, including lights, motors and miscellaneous circuits-----		15.00
For any special equipment not listed-----		2.50

- NOTE:** (1) The fee schedule for transformers shall be the same as set forth for motors - One KVA=1 HP
 (2) The fee schedule for commercial heaters and furnaces shall be the same as set forth for motors - One KW=1 HP

Minimum total fee for any electrical installation shall be----- 5.00

SINGLE AND MULTI-FAMILY DWELLINGS:

For the construction of new single and multi-family dwellings the following flat rate fee, which includes the fee for issuance of permit, shall be used: One Dollar Twenty-Five (\$1.25) per one hundred (100) square feet or fraction thereof of the total living area. This rate will include all work except electric space heaters. This rate does not apply to any other type of construction.

FLOOR AREAS: The floor area shall be based on requirements set forth by Section 220-2 of the National Electrical Code.

SPECIAL FEES: Where more than one re-inspection of any item requiring inspection has to be made because work has not been ready or defects have not been corrected, a fee of \$7.50 will be charged for each additional re-inspection and must be paid before final approval of the work.

Where any special inspection is requested, such as to determine how an existing structure may be made to conform to present code requirements, or otherwise where no current permit is involved, a charge will be made at the rate of \$7.50 per hour of the inspector's time, including travel time, with a minimum charge of \$5.00.

REFUNDS: If a project under any permit is abandoned without any work having been done 80% of the permit fees paid may be refunded on written application and surrender of the permit within 60 days of the date of issuance. If a permit is issued in error, refund of the full fee may be made.


INSPECTIONS: No electrical wire, cable or conduit shall be buried in the ground, incased in masonry or concrete, or enclosed in walls or other concealed spaces in buildings without having first been inspected and approved. If any such work is covered or concealed without being inspected and approved, any construction interfering with inspection shall be removed on demand of the Building Official.
