RESOLUTION NO. 1619

RESOLUTION CONCURRING IN THE COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the Nejedly-Z'berg Dills Solid Waste Management and Resource Recovery Act of 1972 (hereafter referred to as the Act) requires each county in cooperation with affected local jurisdictions, to prepare a comprehensive, coordinated solid waste management plan; and

WHEREAS, said Act also requires that such plan shall be consistent with state policy and any appropriate regional or sub-regional solid waste management plan; and

WHEREAS, said Act also requires that the county solid waste management plan shall be subject to the approval by a majority of the cities within the county which contain a majority of the population of the incorporated area of the county; and

WHEREAS, the County of Marin has prepared a plan for solid waste management in conformance with the Act and on October 14, 1975 submitted said plan to this Council for approval;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of San Anselmo has reviewed said plan and hereby specifically stipulates concurrence in the following: (a) The objectives set forth in the plan, (b) the method and organization for implementation of the programs contained in the plan, (c) the procedures for financing the recommended solid waste management program, and (d) the role identified in the plan for the Town in implementing this cooperative effort for management of solid waste in an economical and environmentally acceptable manner.
