RESOLUTION NO. 1790

A RESOLUTION OF THE SAN ANSELMO TOWN COUNCIL ESTABLISHING
FEES FOR ISSUANCE OF REQUIRED PERMITS UNDER THE PROVISIONS
OF THE UNIFORM FIRE CODE

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that it is necessary to establish a fee schedule to provide reimbursement for the cost of processing, plan checking, inspection, approval and routine inspection necessary for the issuance of permits required by the Uniform Fire Code for maintaining, storing, using or handling materials, or conducting processes which produce conditions hazardous to life or property, or to install equipment used in connection with such activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following fee schedule be adopted immediately upon passage of this resolution:

4.102	<u>Bowling Alleys and Pins:</u> Bowling Pin refinishing and bowling alley resurfacing and finishing operations involving the use and application of flammable liquids or materials.	\$25.00
6.102	<u>Cellulose Nitrate Plastic (pyroxlin):</u> Retailers, jobbers, wholesalers, or other persons storing or handling more than 25 pounds of cellulose nitrate plastic (pyroxlin), manufacture of articles of cellulose nitrate plastics (pyroxlin) in the manufacture or assembling of other articles.	35.00
7.102	<u>Combustible Fibers:</u> Storage or handling of combustible fibers in quantities in excess of 100 cubic feet.	25.00
36.103	<u>Cryogenic Fluids:</u> 1) Production, sale, or storage of cryogenic fluids. 2) Storage of non-flammable, non-toxic cryogenic fluids in excess of 500 gallons. 3) Storage or use of more than 10 gallons of liquified oxygen, flammable cryogenic fluids or cryogenic oxidizers.	25.00
15.103	<u>Flammable liquids and Dry Cleaning:</u> (I) Storage, handling or use of Class I flammable liquids in excess of one gallon in any dwelling or other place of human habitation; or in excess of 5 gallons or in any other building or occupancy; or in excess of 10 gallons outside of any building; except no permit shall be required for the following: 1) The storage or use of flammable liquids in the fuel tank of a motor vehicle, aircraft, motor boat, mobile power plan or mobile heating plant.	25.00

2) For the storage or use of paints, oils, varnishes or similar flammable mixtures when such liquids are stored for maintenance, painting or similar purposes for a period of not more than 30 days.

II) Storage, handling or use of class II, or III liquids in excess of 60 gallons in a building; or in excess of 60 gallons outside a building, except for fuel oil used in connection with oil burning equipment.

III) Installation and use of equipment and premises for the storage, handling, use or sale of flammable or combustible liquids as stated in the Uniform Fire Code.

Explosive or Blasting Agents:

1) To manufacture, possess, store, sell or otherwise dispose of explosives or blasting agents.

2) To transport explosives or blasting agents.

4) To operate a terminal for handling explosives or blasting agents from a carrier at a terminal between the hours of sunset and sunrise.

6) To transport blasting caps or electric blasting caps on the same vehicle with explosives.

Flammable Compressed Gas: Storage, handling or use at normal temperature and pressure of more than 2000 cubic feet of flammable compressed gas or 6000 cubic feet of non-flammable compressed gas.

Fumigation and Thermal Insecticide Fogging

Includes persons engaging in the business of fumigation or thermal insecticide fogging. The use of any fumigation room, vault or chamber using toxic or flammable fumigants.

Hazardous Chemicals:

1) Storage, transportation or handling of more than 55 gallons of corrosive liquids; or more than 500 pounds of oxidizing materials; or more than 10 pounds of organic peroxides; or more than 500 pounds of nitromethane; or 1000 pounds or more of ammonium nitrate, ammonium nitrate fertilizers and fertilizer mixtures covered in section 19.106 (d) of the Uniform Fire Code or any amount of highly toxic materials, cryogenic materials or poisonous gases.

2) Storage or handling at any installation of more than one microcurie of radium or other radioactive material in a sealed source or sources, or any amount of radioactive material for which a specific license from the U. S. Atomic Energy Commission is required.

Liquified Petroleum Gas

Installation or use of any liquified petroleum gas container, or operation of any tank vehicle which is used for the transportation of liquified petroleum gas. Plans shall be submitted where a single container or the aggregate of interconnected containers is over 1200 gallons of water capacity. A permit shall not be required for the installation or maintenance of portable containers of less than 120 gallons of water capacity.

Lumber Storage

Storage in excess of 100,000 board feet of lumber.

23.101	<u>Matches</u> Manufacture of matches or storage in excess of an aggregate 60 matchman's gross (14,400 matches per gross).	25.00
32.102	<u>Motion Picture Projection</u> Operation of motion picture projection machinery in any institutional occupancy or place of public assembly.	25.00
18.103	<u>Motor Vehicle Repair</u> The use of any building, shed or enclosure as a place of business for the purpose of repairing any motor vehicle therein.	25.00
26.101	<u>Places of Assembly</u> The operation of any place of assembly for the gathering together of 50 or more persons for such purposes as deliberation, education, instruction, worship, entertainment, amusement or awaiting transportation, or of 100 or more persons in drinking and dining establishments.	35.00
28.101	<u>Refrigeration Units</u> Installation or operation of a refrigeration unit or system containing in excess of 20 pounds of refrigerant other than air or water.	25.00
35.104	<u>High-Piled Combustible Stock</u> The use of any building or portion of a building for the storage of high piled combustible stock.	15.00
30.101	<u>Tent or Air Supported Structure</u> Erection, operation, maintenance of a tent or air supported structure covering an area in excess of 200 sq. ft. Tents used exclusively for camping purposes shall be exempt from the above requirement.	15.00
2.102	<u>Tire Recapping or Rebuilding Plant</u> Operation or maintenance of any tire recapping or rebuilding plant.	35.00
26.115	<u>Candles and Open Flames</u> Use of any open flame, burning candle, or candles in connection with any public meeting or gathering for purposes of deliberation, worship, entertainment, amusement, instruction, education, recreation, awaiting transportation or similar purpose or in places of public assembly such as churches, schools, restaurants, eating establishments, cocktail lounges or bars.	15.00
3.102	<u>Automotive Wrecking Yards</u> Automotive wrecking yards, junk yards or waste material holding plants.	20.00
