RESOLUTION NO. 1823

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO APPROVING
THE FEDERAL-AID URBAN PROGRAM RECOMMENDED BY THE MARIN COUNTY URBAN
SYSTEM COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Town of San Anselmo desires to continue to participate in the Federal-Aid Urban Program for funding approved transportation projects as authorized by the Federal Highway Act of 1973 and succeeding amendments, and;

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Act, the State Transportation Board and the Metropolitan Transportation Commission require that a program of projects approved for Federal-Aid Urban funding, be established by a County-wide Committee consisting of representatives from each City, the County, Transit District, California Department of Transportation, Golden Gate Bridge District, and the Metropolitan Transportation Commission, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has approved procedures for the Federal-Aid Urban Program and the formation of the Marin County Urban System Committee, and;

WHEREAS, the Marin County Urban System Committee did meet to review the program and new projects which had been submitted for consideration as part of a five-year program; and

WHEREAS, the Marin County Urban System Committee did approve a five-year Federal Aid Urban Program on November 29, 1979.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of San Anselmo does hereby approve the five-year Federal-Aid Urban Program of projects beginning 1980-81 recommended by the Marin County Urban System Committee as follows:


