

RESOLVED by the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo that  
1 a General Municipal Election will be held in said Town of San  
2 Anselmo on Tuesday, the 11th day of April, 1950, for the purpose  
3 of electing the following officers:

4 Three Councilmen for the full term of four years.

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, there will be six voting precincts  
6 for the purpose of holding said election, which precincts shall  
7 be consolidations of the regular election precincts for holding  
8 State and County elections, and shall be as follows:

9 CONSOLIDATED VOTING PRECINCT "A", comprising State and County  
10 Precincts Nos. 217, 230, and 213, and the polling place thereof  
11 shall be the Wade Thomas School, 115 Kensington Road.

12 CONSOLIDATED VOTING PRECINCT "B", comprising State and County  
13 Precincts 232, 218, 219, 231, 215, 233, and 216, and the polling place  
14 thereof shall be at the City Hall, San Anselmo Avenue.

15 CONSOLIDATED PRECINCT "C", comprising State and County  
16 Precincts No. 234, 214, 226, and the polling place thereof shall be  
17 the Isabel Cook School on Sir Francis Drake Blvd. between Sonoma  
18 Avenue and Los Angeles Blvd.

19 CONSOLIDATED VOTING PRECINCT "D", comprising State and County  
20 Precincts No. 227, 235, 220, and the polling place thereof shall be  
21 the Drake School on Sir Francis Drake Blvd. at Saunders Avenue.

22 CONSOLIDATED VOTING PRECINCT "E", comprising State and County  
23 Precincts No. 229, 225, 236, 237, 221, 222, and the polling place there-  
24 of shall be the Brookside School at Brookmead Court.

25 CONSOLIDATED VOTING PRECINCT "E", comprising State and County  
26 Precincts No. 224, 228, 238, 223, and the polling place thereof shall  
27 be the Yolandsdale School on San Anselmo Avenue at Elm Avenue.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Election Officers for said  
29 election shall receive as compensation for their services the  
30 sum of \$ 10<sup>00</sup> each, and they shall be as follows:
